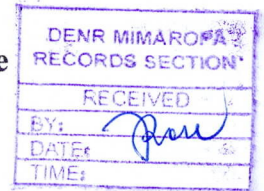

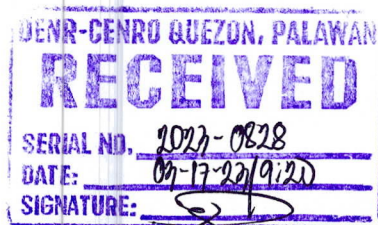

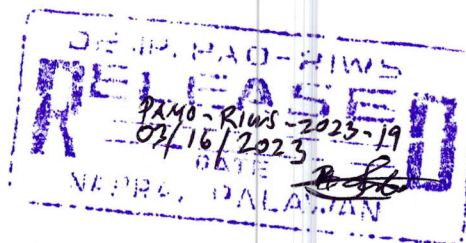

This pertains to the Biodiversity Assessment and Monitoring System Activity under Protected Area Management and Development Sub Program Targets and Activities for FY 2023.

Please be informed that the undersigned together with the Staff of PAMO RIWS have started the conduct of Fauna Monitoring activity within the two (2) hectares Permanent Biodiversity Monitoring Area (PBMA) in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary for the Terrestrial Biodiversity Assessment Monitoring System (BAMS) target this FY 2023. The activity was conducted from February to the present using prescribed methods of BMB Technical Bulletin No's 2016-05 and 2017 – 09.

Simple Line Transect Count was conducted within the 2 has. PBMA for the monitoring of birds or avifauna in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary. Some of the birds species heard and seen during the monitoring were the ff: Philippine Cockatoo (*Cacatua haematuropygia*) locally known as Katala, Philippine Megapode or Tabon Scrubfowl (*Megapodius cumingii*) locally known as Tabon, Grey Imperial Pigeon (*Ducula pickeringii*) and Green Imperial Pigeon (*Ducula aenea*) locally known as Balud, Blue Paradise Flycatcher (*Tersiphone cyanescens*) locally known as Uwid-uwid, Rufous-tailed tailorbird (*Orthotomus sericeus*) locally known as Tikol-tikol, Red-headed Flameback (*Chrysocolaptes erythrocephalus*), Common Koel (*Eudynamys scolopacea*) locally known as Kuwaw or Bahaw, Olive-backed sunbird (*Nectarinia jugularis*), Copper-throated sunbird (*Nectarinia calcostetha*) and Slender-billed crow (*Corvus enca*) locally known as Uwak.

Continuous monitoring of birds, arthropods, herpetofauna, and mammals will be conducted until the end of the dry season. BAMS final report including data analysis and photo documentation will be submitted on or before the 20th of September 2023.

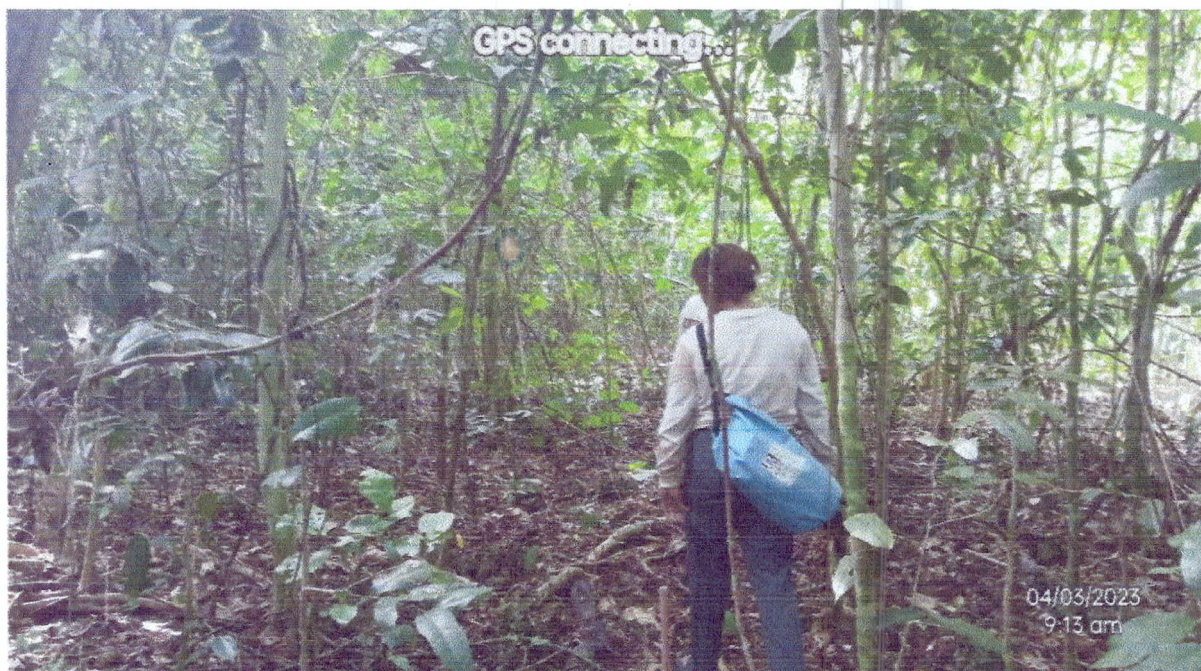
