



The undersigned, together with the Katala Foundation Inc. Field Assistant Michael Plazos and Warden Eddie Derecho and representatives from MENRO, conducted a Philippine Cockatoo or "Katala" (*Cacatua haematuropygia*) monitoring last March 8, 2023 in Dumarán, Palawan.


The team observed five (5) Philippine Cockatoos perching on a Taloto tree (*Pterocymbium tinctorium*) at their roosting site in Sitio Lagan of the abovementioned barangay at around 6:00 in the evening. It was observed that the few Taloto trees in the area are in their fruiting season. Philippine Cockatoos feed on fruits of these trees. This low number of Philippine Cockatoo observed in their roosting site may be because some of them stay in the nests in Sitio Bulalacao, Casipulo, Omoi, and Candes in Barangay Sto. Tomas; Sitio Camaya in Barangay Poblacion; and Sitio Manambaleng in Barangay San Juan as stated by Mr. Micahel Plazos of KFI. Breeding season of this species is from the month of January until the month of June. He further stated that they were able to count fourteen (14) Philippine Cockatoos last February 2023 and seven (7) on March 7, 2023 in the said area. After the devastation of typhoon "Odette", the highest number of count recorded by KFI is twenty-two (22). Philippine Cockatoos are also seen foraging in Barangay Bacao, Barangay Catep, Barangay Calasag, Barangay Sto. Tomas, and Barangay Poblacion.


