

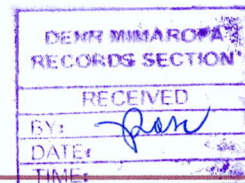

Please be informed that on March 8, 2023 this office initiated the conduct of coastal clean-up in celebration of International Women's Day at Bucana Beach, Sitio Yokoton and Zone 3, Bgy. Bucana, El Nido, Palawan with an approximate distance of 1.65 kilometers. It was participated and attended by a total of ninety-five (95) participants which include sixty-five (65) male and thirty (30) female from Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), Philippine National Police (PNP), Joint Task Force Malampaya (JTFM), 23rd Marine Company MBLT-3, Philippine Navy reservist, Pagkakaisa Pagtutulungan Kalikasan Pagkaingatan (PPKP), Malampaya Foundation Inc. (MFI), Samahan ng Nagkakaisang Magsasaka, Mangingisda, Kababaihan tungo sa Maunlad na Kinabukasan ng Pamayanan (SANMKAP), Barangay Officials of Bucana, Philippine Navy (NAVSOU-10), and Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO).

Based on the report, a total of fifty-nine (59) sacks of marine debris were collected with an estimated weight of nine hundred fifty-two (952) kilograms from the ocean trash data form and properly segregated and disposed of in the designated waste disposal area.

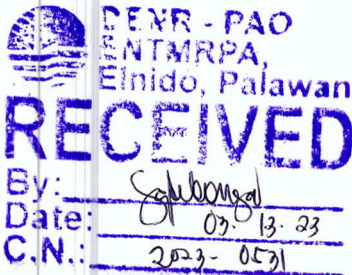

**Why:**

To empower the women's sector and bring awareness to communities about the environment for conservation and protection, especially in coastal areas of ENMRPA.

**How:**

It started with an orientation and roll-call of participants by Information Officer Aljen Becera and followed by welcome message of Bgy. Kagawad Mia B. Mag-Apan, committee on environment, and the focal person on Gender And Development (GAD).

A total of fifty-nine (59) sacks of marine debris were collected with an estimated weight of nine hundred fifty-two (952) kilograms and properly segregated and disposed of by the Barangay of Bucana in the designated waste disposal area. Most of the marine debris collected includes food wrappers, plastic and glass beverage bottles, fishing nets and pieces, fishing line, ropes, diapers, foam pieces, construction material, clothes, and slippers. Moreover, one (1) hatchling of a marine turtle was found dead and entangled.

**Other matters:**

Further, the activity was compliant to the Implementation of Plan of the Office on environmental Management System (EMS), basically the **5S** technique of the organization, namely: 1. Sort, 2. Set in Order, 3. Shine, 4. Standardized, and 5. Sustain.





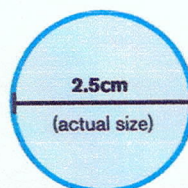
