ORDER

When this case was called today, Atty. Jeffrey M. Mercado of the Public Attorney's Office manifested that his client/accused are willing to plead guilty at a lower fine of P15,000.00 and also moved that the previous plea be withdrawn and that the accused be re-arraigned. The Court grants the same and when re-arraigned the two (2) accused entered a plea of GUILTY.

WHEREFORE, the Court declares the two accused GUILTY BEYOND REASONABLE DOUBT for Violation of Sec. 7, par. (1) of R.A. 9175 otherwise known as the chainsaw act and they are sentenced to pay a fine of P15,000.00 each to be paid today and thereafter, this case is considered closed and terminated with the conviction of the two (2) accused.

The cash bond posted for the temporary liberty of the accused shall be released upon application and the same may be utilized as initial satisfaction of the fine.

The confiscated unregistered chainsaw without serial number which is now in court is declared forfeited in favor of the government and the Court surrenders the same to Mr. Jomar B. Serquiña, an officer and employee of the DENR.
