Please be informed that on March 9, 2023 this office conducted habitat surveillance of threats and damages at Depeldet Island, Bgy. Corong-corong, El Nido, Palawan. Based on the report, the team observed mild coral bleaching and outbreak of Crown of Thorns with an approximate coral reef area of 33.80 hectares.

Furthermore, with the above observation on threats to coral reef, this office will continuously monitor the area and conduct regular COTs extraction together with partners to prevent Crown of Thorns outbreak.


Please be informed that on March 9, 2023, the undersigned, together with Park Ranger Steven John Andao, Accounting Clerk II Reina Rose C. Abordo, and Municipal Environment and Management Resources Office (MENRO) staff, conducted habitat surveillance of threats and damages at Depeldet Reef, Bgy. Corong-corong El Nido, Palawan, with an approximate coral reef area damage of 33.80 hectares.

During monitoring of corals in the said area, the team observed mild coral bleaching and an outbreak of Crown of Thorns. Therefore, the team recommends to conduct Crown of Thorns extraction in the aforementioned area to prevent the invasion of COTs and lessen the impact on coral reefs.
