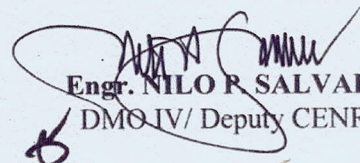

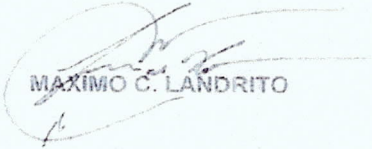
This refers to the letter dated February 21, 2023 of PAGASA PHILIPPINES Finance Corporation regarding the aforementioned subject.

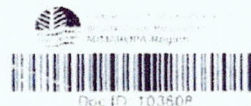
The said corporation is willing to be partner to plant trees, we can offer the NGP graduated sites for possible MOA that could help in sustaining, increasing and developing the NGP areas.
