

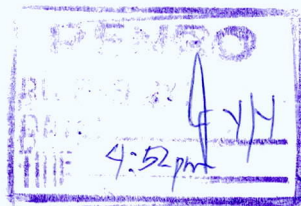
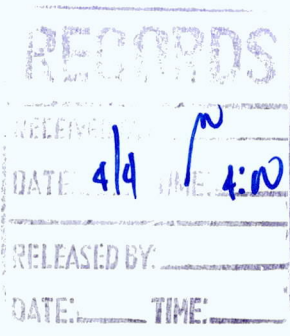
Respectfully submitted herewith is the report of Forester I Lehen B. Bautista regarding the above-mentioned subject.



Vilarmino conducted lecture to MENR Officer Delmar Caringalo regarding hardening-off as the Final Stage of Nursery Care for Seedlings based in DENR Greenbook I. Forester Vilarmino reiterated the ff:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Transfer grown up seedlings to a hardening area. 2. Do not apply fertilizer during the hardening period. 3. Reduce watering and shading gradually 4. Prune all the protruding roots a month before outplanting. 5. For over-sized seedlings, trim the leaves to at least 1/3 of their size to avoid excessive loss of water. <p>MENR Officer Delmar Caringalo assured that he will be cascading and/or re-echoing the relayed essential information to his staff. The said lecture aims to produce a healthy seedlings in preparation for the upcoming Tree Planting Activities-as one of the most effective way for reforestation.</p> |


