Respectfully forwarded is the report of CENRO San Jose regarding the above-mentioned subject in which their Office spearheaded the clean-up activity with the participation of various National Government Agencies namely; (1) Philippine National Police (Provincial Police Office and Municipal Police Office), (2) Bureau of Fire Protection, (3) Philippine Maritime Police, (4) Philippine Army (5) Community Army Reserve, (6) Philippine Coastguard, including the (7) Local Government Unit of San Jose through MENR Office and BLGU.

The activity was participated by 124 participants from various National Agencies and Local Offices wherein 84 are male and 40 are female. The areas cleaned were creek, riverside and the coastal area covering, overall, a total of 1.7 km.

The total estimated volume of wastes collected is 7 tons with consideration to the weight added since the wastes are mostly covered with mud according to the MENR Office.

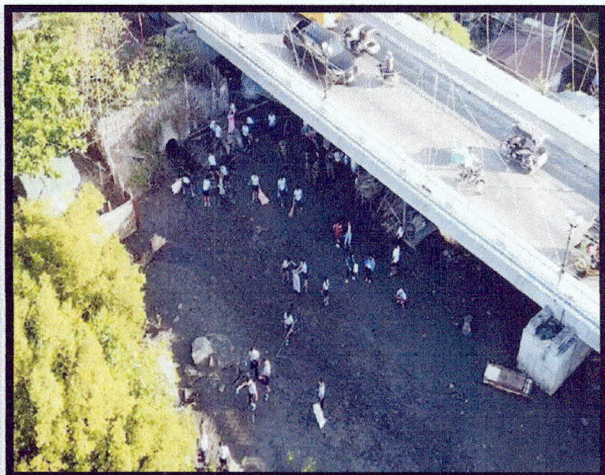
