REPORT ON THE MONITORING ACTIVITIES OF WILDLIFE

ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF MONITORING AND ENFORCEMENT

SECTION FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH CY 2023

In accordance with the target of this Office under Operation Against Illegal Environment and Natural Resources Mobilization of Wildlife Enforcement Officers (WEO), please be informed that the undersigned personnel of Monitoring and Enforcement Section together with the deputized Wildlife Enforcement Officers conducted the following activities in relation with the afore-mentioned subject target, to wit;

- On March 01-02, 2023, the undersigned together with the staff of Conservation and Development Section rescued and released sixty (60) hatchlings of hawksbill turtles in Barangay Lupac, Boac, Marinduque.
- On March 03, 2023, the undersigned together with deputized Wildlife Enforcement Officers Firefigther I CAAP of Boac, Marinduque Mr. Michael J. Olivar and Mr. Dante de Luna of Provincial Government Environment of Marinduque (PGENR) attended "World Wildlife Day" and inauguration of marine turtle hatchery in Barangay Masiga, Gasan, Marinduque. Likewise, discussed conservation and protection of wildlife resources and their habitats pursuant to Republic Act No. 9147 "Wildlife Conservation and Protection Act" and other DENR forestry laws, rules and regulations.
- On March 17, 2023 at around 4:30 PM, a total of ninety (90) green sea turtle hatchlings were released in Barangay Masiga, Gasan, Marinduque with the assistance of Barangay Officials, coastal residents and PNP-MPS personnel of Gasan, Marinduque. Likewise, additional seventy-two (72) green sea turtle hatchlings were released in the same area.
- A total of Eighty One (81) Local Transport Permit with different butterflies species such as Danaus Genutia, Attacus Atlas, P. Romansubia, I. Leuconoe, Vindula Dejone, P. Valeria, P. Rumansubia, P. Demoteus, P. Palinurus, Danaus, Chrysippus, P. Lowi, A. Semperi, Troides, Rhadamantus, Romansovia, Appias Albina, Graphium Agamemnon, Euploea Mulciber, Hecabe, were inventoried and documented in preparation for the issuance of Local Transport Permit.






