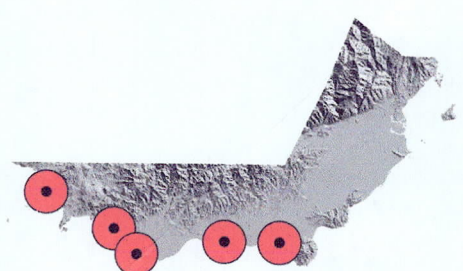
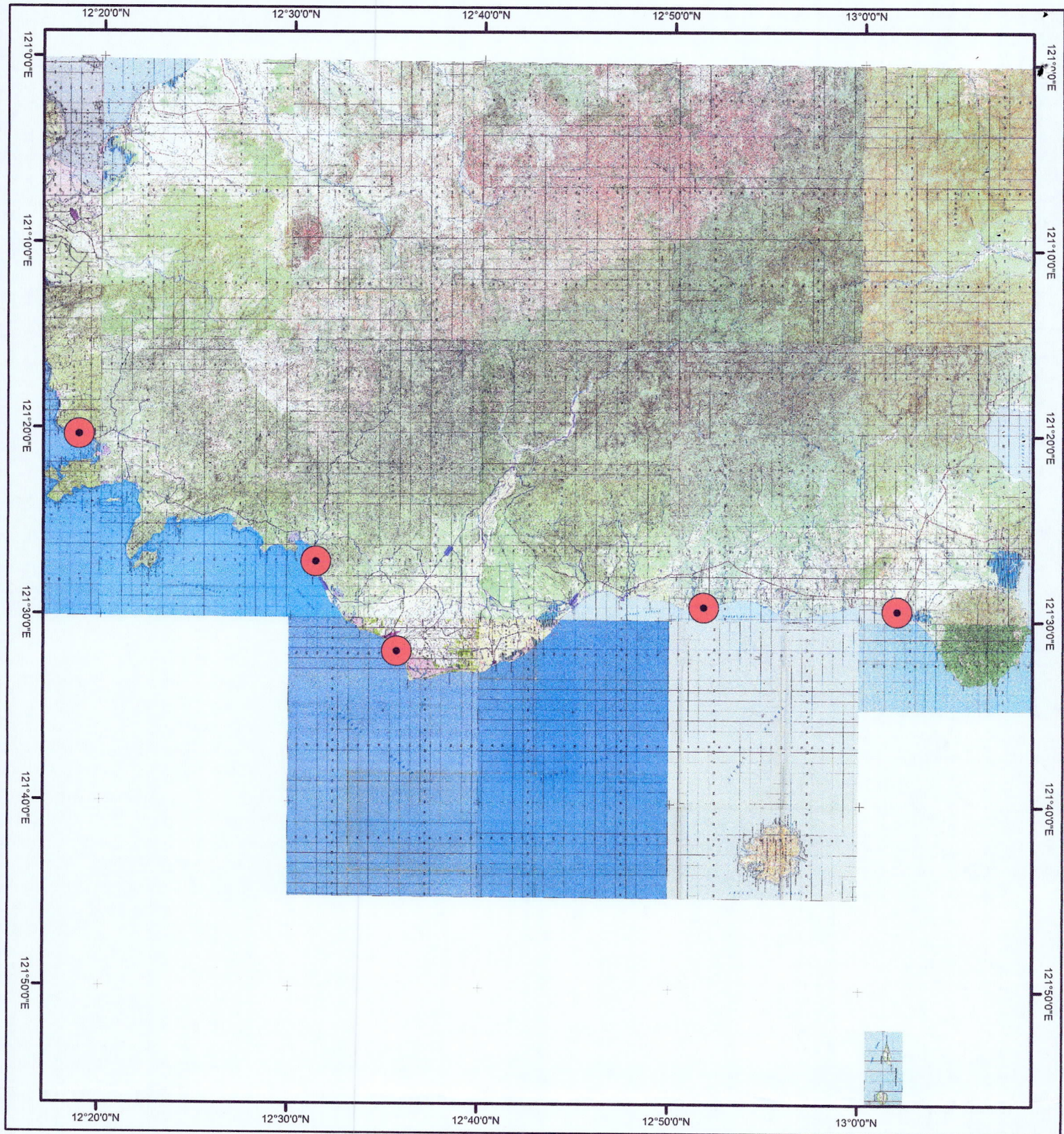
Pursuant to Section 77 of PD 705 (*Forestry Code of the Philippines*) and RA 9147 (*Wildlife Conservation Act*) and in order to strengthen the enforcement of these laws, the Wildlife Monitoring Teams of CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro spearheaded the inspection of the incoming and outgoing conveyances in five ports within this office's jurisdiction.

During monitoring with the partner agencies (LGU and PPA), the teams did not see/observed smuggled forest products and wildlife.

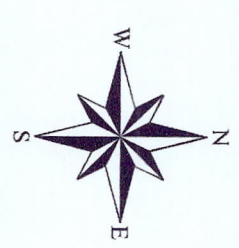

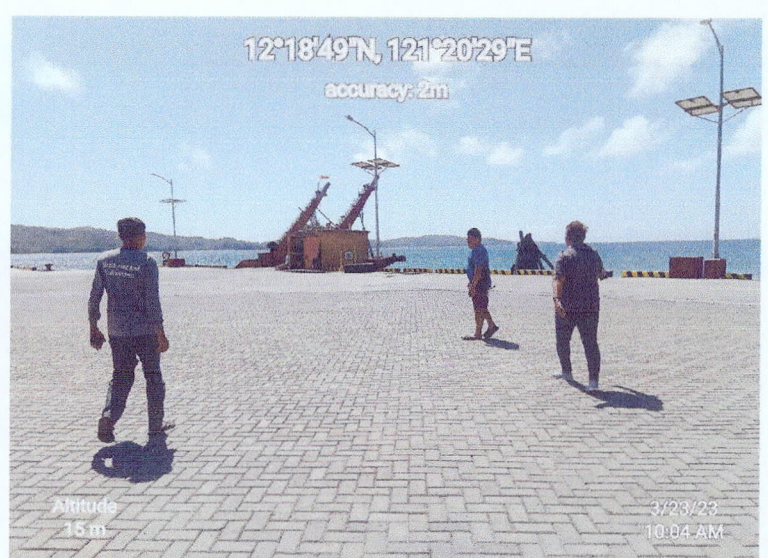
