

This pertains to the Maintenance and Protection of coastal and Marine Ecosystem activity in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary under Coastal and Marine Ecosystems Management Program for FY 2023.

Please be informed that the PAMO-RIWS staff are observing the Gender and Development (GAD) mainstreaming in the conduct and implementation of all Protected Area activities.

On February 7, 2023, at about 10 o'clock in the morning, the PAMO-RIWS staff in coordination with wardens have apprehended a set of assembled trawl within the coastal area of Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary with coordinates of 09°13'37" North and 118°25'25" East during the conduct of regular habitat surveillance and patrolling activity but no offenders were seen in the area during the apprehension. The above-said location was identified as site with potential threats and damages to the coral reef ecosystems in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary. In addition, notice to the public re: the apprehended trawl in RIWS was posted in the adjacent Barangays, particularly in Brgys. Panacan, Panacan II and Antipuluan, Narra, Palawan. The incident has already been informed through a letter dated February 27, 2023 to BFAR, the Office of the Municipal Mayor, PNP Maritime, PCG, and the three Barangays of Panacan I, Panacan II, and Antipuluan for further assistance. A report on the said apprehended trawl was also submitted to CENRO Quezon, Palawan dated February 22, 2023, for information.

Regular habitat surveillance including patrolling and monitoring activity is continuously conducted particularly on the monitoring of markers/buoys installed within the boundary of Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary. The outrigger/katig was damage due to strong waves and is currently under repair for the maintenance of PAMO-RIWS motorized boat.

Attached herewith is the map of the site surveyed with potential threats and damages and photos relative to the above subject.




