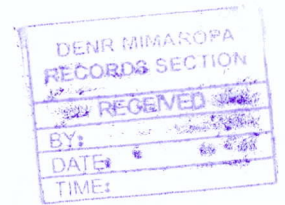

Please be informed that the monitoring of marine turtles in the said island is being conducted continuously. Hence, during the first quarter period of this year, a total of 529 eggs were collected from 6 nests wherein 39 out of 95 eggs in one nest have already hatched and released.

This serves as **Means of Verification (MoV)** for target activities under Wildlife Resources Conservation Sub-Program – Conservation of Threatened Species for CY 2023.

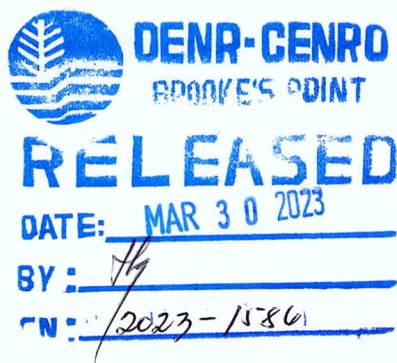


Respectfully submitting herewith is the first quarter marine turtle monitoring report of ECOMS I Mary Cris A. Ibañez.

Please be informed that assigned Forest Protection Officers at Ursula Island Wildlife Sanctuary is continuously conducting monitoring and documenting the incidence of Marine Turtles in the island. Per report, transferred eggs has a total of 529 and hatched eggs and hatchlings released has a total of 39 for this quarter. Marine turtle specie recorded was the Green Sea Turtle and Hawksbill Turtle.

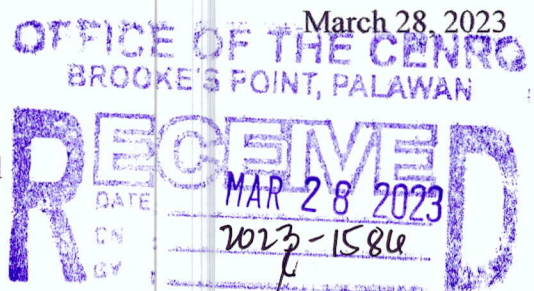

SUBJECT : **SUBMISSION OF REPORT RE: FIRST QUARTER MARINE TURTLE HATCHERY MONITORING AT URSULA ISLAND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY (UIWS)**

Respectfully submitting herewith is our report regarding the above-cited subject.

Please be informed that assigned Forest Protection Officers at Ursula Island are regularly conducting monitoring of the Marine Turtles in the island as one of the identified marine turtle nesting site within the jurisdiction of CENRO Brooke's Point. Eggs of marine turtles are properly collected and transferred to temporary hatchery area near the Ranger house since the constructed hatchery area of Ursula was damaged by strong waves due to shear line last January 2023. Eggs are collected and transferred to protect from predation and other threats. Furthermore, number of eggs hatched and released hatchlings were also properly documented.

This quarter, there were 529 eggs of Marine Turtles (Hawksbill and Green Sea Turtle) collected and transferred in the temporary hatchery area and 39 eggs hatched and released hatchlings of hawksbill turtle on March 23, 2023. Eggs hatched are the transferred eggs on January 21, 2023.

Attached is the filled-out Marine Turtle Monitoring Forms from January to March 2023 including the photo documentation taken by FPOs during the monitoring and map showing the nesting sites of marine turtles this quarter CY 2023.

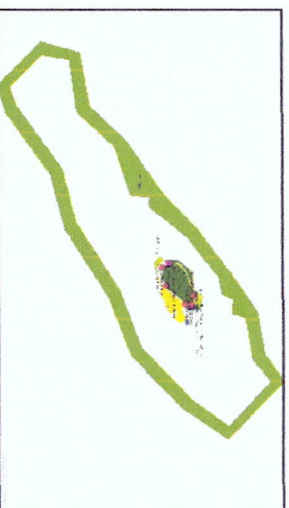
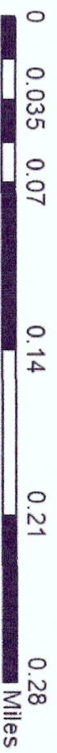
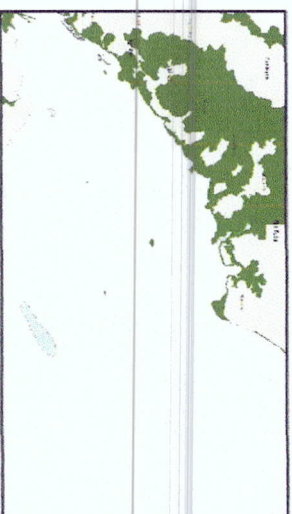
