

Out of 160 tenured migrants, a total of sixty (60) households were monitored using SEAMS Form 1 for the first quarter of CY 2023. It is important to note that, based on the demarcated boundary in 2019, out of the sixty (60) households monitored, fifty-seven (57) of them are already outside the protected area, and also based on interviews, they are not using any resources there.




