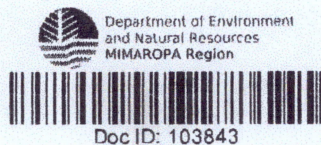
This pertains to the Memorandum dated February 9, 2023 of PENRO Romblon regarding the abovementioned subject.



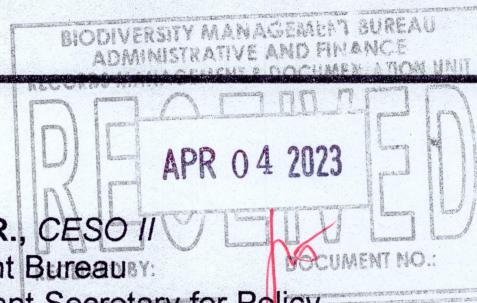

Respectfully forwarded is the Memorandum dated March 02, 2023 from PENRO Palawan and its enclosures regarding the report of CENRO-Taytay on the one (1) head of Palawan Leopard Cat (*Prionailurus bengalensis heaneyi*) which was found dead at So. Batbat, Brgy. Villa, Liberta, El Nido, Palawan on January 29, 2023.

The personnel of Protected Area Management Office –El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected Area (PAMO-ENTMRPA) had retrieved the reported wildlife for documentation and proper disposition. Said wildlife was measured approximately 40 cm in length and possibly was a victim of road accident and already coordinated with the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) as the lead agency in the implementation of RA 9147 in the province of Palawan.

Be informed that NGP projects within identified Barangays under NTF-ELCAC have an aggregate total area for development of 783.14 hectares located in seven (7) ELCAC Barangays, in **Cabacao, Naibuan, Batasan** in Occidental Mindoro, **Milagrosa, San Isidro** in Oriental Mindoro, **Salogon, and Samariniana** in Palawan with 337 engaged families.


Relative thereto, a total area of 783.14 hectares with 403,777 seedlings is being maintained under the jurisdiction of PENRO Oriental Mindoro, Occidental Mindoro and PENRO Palawan for 3<sup>rd</sup> year maintenance and protection activities.

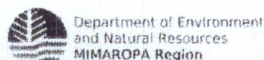
As to the financial status, a total of Php 1,076,600.00 of contracted amount was disbursed by PENRO Occidental Mindoro.
