Forwarded is the report of CENRO Socorro regarding the evaluation/assessment of expired Certificate of Stewardship Contracts (CSC) in Barangays Balatero and San Isidro, Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro.

Based on the report, it was found out that there were discrepancies in the location of CSCs when compared in the technical descriptions in the original map and the GIS generated maps.

Thus, this Office reiterates the previous memorandum of CENRO Socorro dated August 17, 2022, for the re-surveying of 11 CSC holders who developed and improved their areas, and the cancellation of 77 CSC holders due to abandonment and lack of improvement of the areas being occupied.

This pertains to the memorandum dated February 22, 2023 of OIC, PENR Officer Alan L. Valle with attached memorandum from the Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services Maximo C. Landrito regarding on the evaluation/assessment of expired Certificate of Stewardship Contracts (CSC) at Barangays Balatero and San Isidro, Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro.

Relative to this, please be informed that based on the original map, the areas are said to be located at Sitio Kaiwangan in Barangay Balatero and Sitios Alowon and Binagbag in Barangay Bigaan. But when projected to the GIS generated maps using the technical description from the original map, most areas fall at Barangays Balatero, Baclayan and Tabinay Malaki, while some other CSCs overlapped with the other CSCs resulting to the discrepancy of the locations. As a result the locations of the geotagged photos are inconsistent with the original technical description of the CSCs.

Consistent thereto, this office reiterates the recommendation from the previous memorandum from this Office dated August 17, 2022 for the **re-surveying** of those eleven (11) CSC holders who developed and improved their areas while for cancellation on the seventy seven (77) CSC holders due to abandonment and no improvement of the areas being occupied.


This pertains to the Memorandum from the Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services regarding the above-captioned subject.

Based on the review/plotting, the submitted shapefiles have different location with that of the geotagged photos. Also, shapefiles of some of the (88) CSCs overlapped with other CSCs (please see map).



Submitted is the report of CENRO Socorro on the assessment/evaluation of 88 CSC form lots within their administrative jurisdiction. The said area coasists of an aggregate area of 184/80 bectares located at Barangays Balatero and Scit Isidro, Puerto Culera, Oriental Mindore.

Based on the result of evaluation and assessment, seventy-seven (77) of the eighty-eight (88) CSCs are recommended for cancellation due to failed performance while the remaining eleven (11) were recommended for renewal. Other Findings were the inconsistency of the locations of the CSC areas to the projection on the original maps, hence re-surveying, especially those that are mera for renewal was recommended by CENRO Socorro, Kindle be informed also that these areas are also part of CADC-126 occupied by the Iraya Mangyan Tribe.

Respectfully submitting the Complete Staff Work on the assessment/evaluation of eighty eight (88) CSC farmiots with an aggregate area of 254-87 hectares conducted at Barangays Balatero and San Isidro, Puerto Galera, Oriental Miridoro.


Passed on the result of the evaluation assessment, out of eighty eight (88), seventy seven (77) CSC areas are recommended for cancellation due to failed performance while eleven (11) of the CSC areas assessed/evaluated were recommended for renewal. However, upon projection of the peological pictures to the GIS-generated maps using the technical description of the original map, it was found out that the areas occupied, improved and known to be the site by the CSC holders are of different locations. In the original map, the CSC areas are said to be located in Barangay's Balatero and San Isidro, but when projected to the GIS generated maps the areas are located in Barangay Tabinay Malaki in the same municipality of Puerto Galera. Hence, this office recommends the re-surveying of the subject CSC especially of those areas that merit renewal.


Please be informed further, that these areas are also part of CADC-126 being occupied by the Iraxa Mangyan Tribe.






