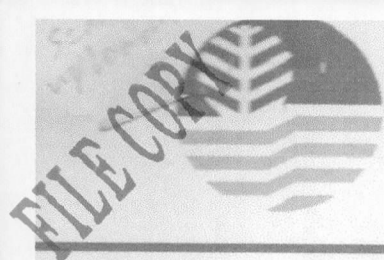

The subject activity will entail a total of Nine Million Sixty-Eight Thousand Pesos (Php9,068,000.00) in accordance with the approved CY 2023 Work and Financial Plan inclusive of the 5% Project and Monitoring and Supervision (PMS) cost. The total physical target to be sampled is at One Thousand Nine Hundred Nineteen (1,919) hectare sample plots of graduated NGP sites from CY 2011 to 2014 and an equivalent Ninety Seven (97) total contracts/ Key Informant Interviews (KII) within the Province of Oriental Mindoro.

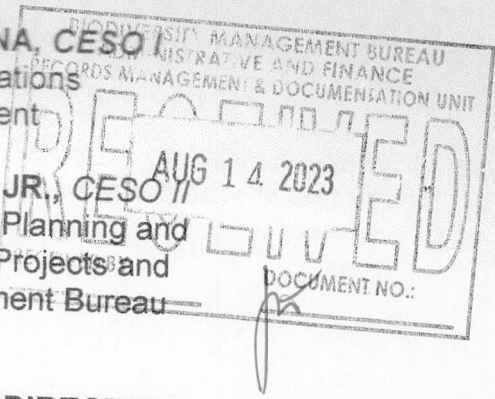

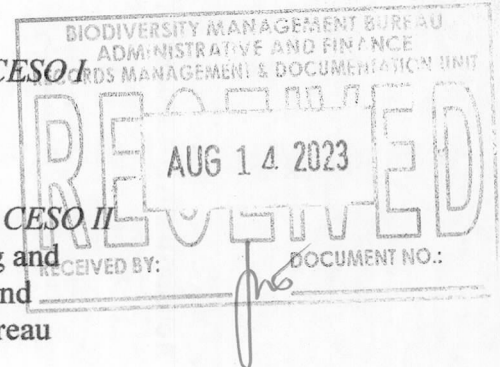

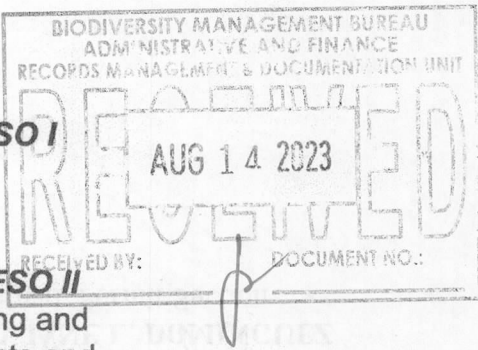

Respectfully submitted are the Memoranda with various dates of PENROs Occidental Mindoro, Oriental Mindoro, Marinduque and Palawan regarding the above subject in compliance with the target under OO1: Natural Resources Conservation and Development Program: *Wildlife Resources Conservation Sub Program, Protection and Conservation of Wildlife; Asian Waterbird Census (AWC) in MIMAROPA.*

The Asian Waterbird Census was conducted simultaneously on the first week up to the third week of January 2023 within the sixteen (16) established permanent observation sites in the four (4) provinces of the region (Marinduque, Occidental Mindoro, Oriental Mindoro and Palawan).
