Please be informed that on April 20-21, 2023, the Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES) of CENRO Taytay, Palawan, held a series of IEC activities within Brgys. Bagong Bayan, Bebeladan, and Manlag in El Nido. On May 19, 2023, the MES of CENRO Quezon, Palawan conducted the same activity within Brgy. Punta Baja, Rizal. Both IEC activities were participated by the residents of the concerned communities as well as personnel of Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGUs). The IEC focused on the discussion of existing ENR laws, rules, and regulations as well as in mobilizing the citizenry in the protection, conservation, and management of natural resources.

The PENRO Marinduque had conducted series of IEC activities on February 15, 18, and April 19, 2023 in Brgy. Sibuyao, Torrijos; Brgy. Tungib-Lipata, Buenavista, and Brgy. Antipolo in Gasan. Said activities were also attended by the residents of the concerned communities as well as personnel of Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGUs). The topics discussed were Forestry and Wildlife related laws, rules, and regulations as well as the Magna Carta of Women (MCW). PENRO Marinduque also distributed IEC materials including flyers on MCW to further promote the role and participation of women in ENR activities.

What:

Information, Education and Communication (IEC) campaign/meeting in compliance to the target of the Office on involving forest communities in forest protection works under the Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES).

Where and When:

A series of IECs was held at Barangay Covered Court of Bagong Bayan (9:30 AM, April 20, 2023); Barangay Covered Court of Bebeladan (2:30 PM, April 20, 2023); and Barangay Covered Court of Manlag, (9:30 AM, April 21, 2023, Holiday), all barangays of El Nido, Palawan.

Who and Whom:

On April 20, 2023, the IEC team was composed by Development Management Officer IV Mariano P. Lilang Jr.; Forest Technician I Rodel M. Dorado; and Forest Ranger Richard Papiñas together with Forester II Donna C. Tabernilla, Chief, Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES); Forester I Michael M. Marasigan; Forest Technician II Bienvenido Veguilla III, Team Leader, Forest Product Monitoring Station II-Bagong Bayan; Forest Ranger Yolando Edep Jr.; Admin. Aide VI Cañette dela Rosa; Ms. Aljen Becera, Information Officer of El Nido Managed Resource Protected Area (ENMRPA) and Mr. Christian Villamor of Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) El Nido. The target partners in involvement to forest protection are the persons whose names appear in the accompanying attendance sheet in response to the prior coordination letters to the Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGUs).

The following were the attendance details:

1. A total of 28 individuals composed of 16 males and 12 females participated in the said activity in Barangay Bagong Bayan, El Nido, Palawan. Nine (9) of them were senior citizens.
2. A total of 59 individuals composed of 10 males and 49 females participated in the said activity in Barangay Bebeladan, El Nido, Palawan. Ten (10) of them were senior citizens.

3. A total of 56 individuals composed of 30 males and 26 females participated in the said activity in Barangay Manlag, El Nido, Palawan. Ten (10) of them were senior citizens. A considerable number of them later revealed to be engaging in small quarry operation.
4. A total of 143 individuals were reached by the IEC team for the period of two (2) days.

Why:

The purpose of the activity, other than attaining the target in the Work and Financial Plan this year under the Monitoring and Enforcement Section, is to help put into actual practice of *mobilizing the citizenry in protecting, conserving, and managing the environment and natural resources* exactly as what the DENR mission is.

How:

In further compliance to Environmental Management System (EMS) of the Department and maximize resources, time, and opportunity, other environmental laws and policies apart from forestry related were incorporated in the dissemination, such as Presidential Decree 1067, Republic Act 7942, Republic Act 7586 as amended, Public Land Act as amended, and among others deemed to tackle during the Question and Answer portion.

The following were presented/discussed:

- Brief information about the El Nido Managed Resource Protected Area (ENMRPA) profile by Ms. Becera;
- Salient provisions of PD 705 by For. Tabernilla;
- Proper waste management and the local policy about no to single-use plastic by Mr. Villamor;
- Brief information re: the El Nido Green Economy Model (GEM) project and PowerPoint presentation of various laws mentioned above; and
- DMO IV Lilang promptly answered queries about sand and gravels extraction/utilization and land matters such as tax declaration and land titling process.

Issues and Concerns:

Other matters:

Further, the activity was compliant to the Implementation Plan of the Office on Environmental Management System (EMS), basically the 5S technique of the organization, namely: 1. Sort, 2. Set in Order, 3. Shine, 4. Standardize, and 5. Sustain. The team also distributed posters and locally produced pamphlets on environmental laws. In addition, goods (2 kilos of rice, 1 pack of noodle and 1 can of sardines) were also distributed to the attendees who actively participated in the question and answer portion of the activity.

emphasized and explicitly discussed that only those existing kaingin areas are allowed to be cleared and develop, the clearing/opening of new forested areas is strictly prohibited by law. Further, Section 9 (Chapter III) of R.A. 8371 (IPRA) was also discussed stating the responsibilities of ICCs/IPs to preserve, restore and maintain the ecological balance in the ancestral domain by protecting the natural resources therein and conduct rehabilitation of denuded areas;

- d. Further, it was discussed that DENR recognizes the utilization of timbers for usual house construction in consonance with their existing culture and tradition provided that the house to be constructed is situated within the CADC area, provided further that they will not utilize chainsaws in cutting and preparing wood materials for construction especially if it is not registered and most of all the need to secure necessary permit. The IPs were informed that in spite of the rights and privileges provided with them under R.A. 8371 such as the right of ownership and right to develop land and natural resources, however, utilization of timbers and other forest products/resources are still regulated by existing laws and policies.
- e. In connection with the preparation of kaingin areas, in which setting of fire is traditionally undertaken to clear the kaingin area, the IPs were reminded and warned to be careful as it may cause forest fire. With this, violations and corresponding penalties involving such forest destruction was discussed.
- f. Furthermore, the communities were informed on the requirements and processing of application for tree cutting permit both on planted trees and naturally grown trees within timberland with appropriate tenurial instrument and within titled properties.
- g. Lastly, the Gender and Development (GAD) was also briefly discussed informing the equal rights of men and women in the community. The IPs were informed of their important role in the protection of natural resources, encouraging them to participate and pro-active in any activities involving forest protection.

4. Objectives:

- a. To inform the participants and increase their awareness about the overall functions of DENR and for them to know the key officials of DENR such as the secretary, the RED of MIMAROPA, the PENRO Palawan and the key officials of DENR-CENRO Quezon;
- b. To inform the participants the Vision, Mission and Mandate of DENR and to emphasize the Mission citing the importance of unity of every citizen in maintaining a healthy environment;
- c. To discuss existing laws/policies governing illegal logging, destruction of forest and kaingin making, illegal occupation of timberland, charcoal making, easement issues, illegal wildlife trade and forest fire;
- d. To inform the communities on the requirements and processing of application for tree cutting permit;

5. Major issues and concerns raised during IEC:

- a. Are they allowed to utilize/cut their planted trees within the CADC area?
- b. Are they allowed to engage in selling of round timbers?
- c. Are they allowed to engage in charcoal making (personal use and commercial purposes) in the forested area within the CADC?
- d. Are they (IPs) allowed to use timbers for their house construction/tribal hall and other related structures?
- e. Are they (IPs) allowed to open new areas/forest for kaingin making especially for those new couples?
- f. Can they be allowed to apply for lumber dealer permit?
- g. How to apply for tree cutting permit?

6. Significant point of discussions in response to the raised issues and concerns:

- a. For construction of tribal facility and related structure / houses, they were advised to coordinate to CENRO Quezon for proper advice and processing for tree cutting permit /utilization especially for their planted trees inside the CADC area in consonance to their approved Ancestral Domain Sustainable Development and Protection Program (ADSDPP).
- b. In the issue of charcoal making and gathering/selling of round timbers, the IPs were asked if charcoal making and selling of round timbers are part of their rights, authority, cultural and indigenous practices as provided for under the IPRA Law, all of the tribal leaders responded that these are not part of their culture and tradition. With this, the IPs were advised not to adopt destructive practices which are not part of their cultural practices and tradition;
- c. The local communities (indigenous peoples) were informed that DENR recognizes their traditional means of farming which is the kaingin making. However, it was





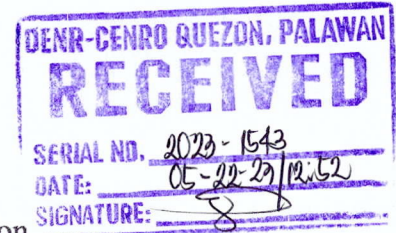

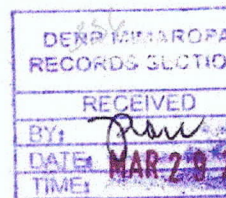

In compliance with the target for CY 2023 under 5.1 Involvement of Forest Communities in forest protection works, please be informed that on February 15, 2023 Monitoring and Enforcement Section conducted Communication, Education, Public Awareness (CEPA) in Barangay Sibuyao, Torrijos, Marinduque.

The activity was held at the Barangay Hall of Barangay Sibuyao Torrijos, Marinduque last February 8, 2023 at 10:30 in the morning. The activity was started with an opening prayer followed by the singing of the National Anthem. Welcome message was delivered by Barangay Councilor Jocelyn L. Landoy of Barangay Sibuyao, Torrijos, Marinduque designated by the Barangay Captain due to conflict of schedule.

The first topics that were discussed are the Legal Basis and Definitions of Gender and Development, and the Magna Carta of Women (RA 9710) presented by Ms. Sarah Jane L. Montalban, GAD Focal Officer. The presenter explained to the participants the current situation regarding the issues on the rights and roles of woman in nation building.

The second topic was the Ecological Solid Waste Management otherwise known as Republic Act. In compliance with the target for CY 2023 under 5.1 Involvement of Forest Communities in forest protection works, please be informed that on February 08, 2023 DENR-PENRO Marinduque thru the Technical Services Division's Monitoring and Enforcement Section conducted Communication, Education, Public Awareness (CEPA) in Barangay Tungib-Lipata Buenavista, Marinduque.

The activity was held at the open court of Barangay Tungib-Lipata Buenavista Marinduque last February 8, 2023 at 9:30 in the morning. The activity started by an opening prayer followed by singing of National Anthem. Welcome message was delivered by Barangay Councilor Randy R. Valencia of Barangay Tungib-Lipata, Buenavista, Marinduque. He was designated the Barangay Captain for health reason.

The first topics that were discussed are the Legal Basis and Definitions of Gender Development, and the Magna Carta of Women (RA 9710) presented by Ms. Sarah Jane Montalban, GAD Focal Officer. The presenter explained to the participants the current situation regarding the issues on the rights and roles of women in nation building.

The next topic is the features of Marinduque Wildlife Sanctuary presented by Forster Glaiza M. Peñaflorida of the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO). She discussed the importance and roles of Marinduque Wildlife Sanctuary in terms of ecosystem services and importance why it needs to be regulated and protected, the cultural, and other services the protected area provides not only to the nearby communities but to the whole province of Marinduque. She also mentioned the challenges that the PAMO is facing in managing and protecting the MWS. It was further explained Section 20 of Expanded National Integrated Protected Area System (ENIPAS) and other different prohibited acts of the said RA. Also discussed Conservation and Protection of Wildlife otherwise known as Republic Act No. 9766.

Mr. Ronald M. Matining of the National Greening Program (NGP) explained the project and reminded the participants in their role on the project that was implemented in Barangay Tungib-Lipata. He further explained that the program was intended to them as well.




After the presentation, it was followed by an open forum facilitated by Forester Bernadine Jasul. The participants provided some issues and concern and the team provided them with all the answers and solutions regarding tree cuttings, renewal of chainsaw and the proper disposal of solid waste. Other issues that were raised are the; 1.) Possibility of community engagement in the seedling production as part of their livelihood and for them to earn additional income; 2.) Issue on the political boundary conflicts in the area. For. Mijares explained that the willingness of the community to produce seedlings is very much welcome. The team encouraged them to proceed with their plan to produce seedlings and promised them to provide technical assistance if requested. This initiative by the community will limit other members of the community to engage in illegal activities like charcoal making which is accordingly is rampant in the area. For the boundary conflict, the participants were informed that political boundary conflict can only be resolved between the two barangays in conflict through the intercession of the municipal LGU of Buenavista together with the DENR-PENRO Marinduque and the NAMRIA.


