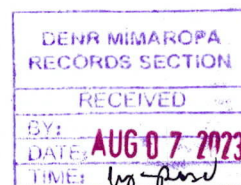


At the end of the course, participants will be given a Certificate of Completion, provided that all course requirements were satisfactorily complied.
