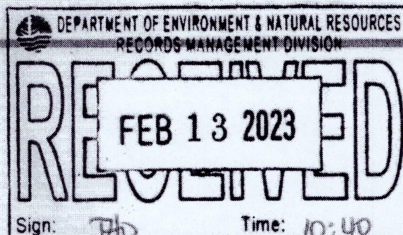

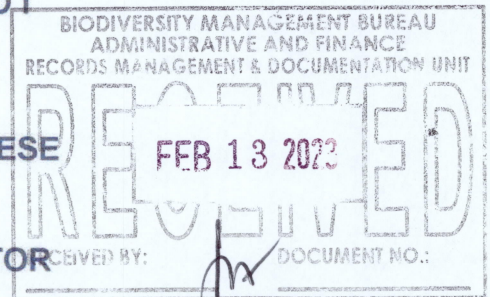

Respectfully submitted are copies of the approved and/or corrected minutes of regular meetings and resolutions of Mts. Iglit-Baco Natural Park (MIBNP) Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) held on March 08, 2022, May 11, 2022, and August 24, 2022 per Memoranda dated July 5, 2022 and October 21, 2022 of the OIC PENRO Occidental Mindoro.

1. March 8, 2022

The *minutes of regular meeting* is a corrected version that was read and approved by the PAMB during their 2nd quarter CY 2022 regular meeting held on May 11, 2022. This was attended by eighteen (18) out of thirty-five (35) PAMB members/representative(s) through a combination of face-to-face and virtual set-up held at Aroma Family Hotel and Resort Complex, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro. The representative of the provincial government of Occidental Mindoro, Mr. Lord Priam Cordova, presided the meeting. Copies of four (4) approved and one (1) deferred resolutions were already submitted per memorandum of this Office dated August 11, 2022.

Regarding PAMB Resolution No. 2022-02 re *Kapasiyahang naghahayag ng pagsang-ayon at pag-apruba sa kahilingan ng Tamisan Elementary School sa paggamit ng 499 bd.ft. na salvaged na puno ng gmelina na matatagpuan sa Sitio Tamisan Dos, Brgy. Poypoy, Calintaan, Occidental Mindoro*, its approval was deferred by this Office pending submission of relevant documents. However, it was learned that the cutting of Gmelina trees has already been effected based on the minutes of meeting on May 11, 2022. Hence, this Office has instructed the PASu through the PENRO to clarify whether a cutting/culling permit was issued by the PASu and whether there are *terms, conditions and criteria* been established/ issued by the PAMB as required in Section 11-B, paragraph i of RA 7586 as amended by RA 11038.

Although, the issuance of permit for *cutting of planted trees and culling of exotic species within Multiple Use Zones of Protected Areas* is delegated to the undersigned per DAO 2022-10, page 38, said DAO was issued on May 30, 2022
