

This pertains to her Memorandum dated December 23, 2022 referring the Memorandum dated December 19, 2022 from the Undersecretary for Field Operations – Luzon, Visayas and Environment forwarding the Memorandum dated December 13, 2022 of the Undersecretary and Chief of Staff, and letter dated September 6, 2022 from Director Jaime Llaguno Mabilin of Presidential Complaint Center concerning the above-subject letter complaint of Mr. Jonathan Miano, Jr. dated August 23, 2022 wherein the latter alleged that the Ipilan Nickel Corporation (INC) has been operating without securing the necessary permits and clearances from the concerned government agencies; particularly citing that the said mining company had constructed an access road and pier/causeway without the corresponding permits and clearances.

Relative thereto, this office had been directed to conduct verification concerning the subject complaint. Likewise, as indicated in the Memorandum from Undersecretary Atty. Juan Miguel T. Cuna, report re: actions taken citing document tracking number DENR CO-ASRMD 2022-023806 should be furnished to their Office and parties concerned.

In line with this, it is informed that per verification from record of this Office, a **Provisional Permit No. 045306-001** for provisional use for causeway/industrial purpose over a foreshore land covering an area of 118, 580 sq. m. located at Barangay Maasin, Brooke's Point, Palawan was granted to Ipilan Nickel Corporation dated June 1, 2022 valid until June 1, 2023. Said Provisional Permit has been issued in line with existing DENR Rules and Regulations such as DAO Nos. 98-20, 2004-24, 2010-26 and 2022-07 and pursuant to the

provisions of Act No. 3077 and Lands Administrative Order No. 8-3. The same area is also covered by a Miscellaneous Lease Application No. 045306-13. Likewise, in accordance with Memorandum dated April 10, 2006 of Secretary Angelo T. Reyes *re: 25-Year Forestry Leases, Permits, Contracts and Related Agreements*, Memorandum dated November 29, 2013 of Undersecretary for Field Operations Demetrio L. Ignacio *re: Lifting of Suspension on the Issuance of SLUPs including OLPs* and DAO 2004-59 *re: Rules and Regulations Governing the Special Uses of Forestland*, a **Special Land Use Permit No. DENR MIMAROPA 2022-001 for Access Road** which will expire on March 18, 2025 has been granted to INC which original copy was released by this Office to the company upon payment of the required government share and performance bond in compliance with the Memorandum Instruction dated March 17, 2022 of the Regional Executive Director.

Moreover, this Office together with Senior EMS Leonora Mansueto and EnMO Ralph Noel C. Navarro of EMB PEMO Palawan and Barangay Captain Domingo Bernas of BLGU Maasin had already previously conducted an actual inspection and verification relative to the said complaint last September 2, 2022 in response to the same letter complaint from Mr. Miano which was received by this Office on August 23, 2022 thru email. During the inspection and verification activity, the company presented copies of permits/documents issued by concerned government agencies which supports the legality of their operation such as the aforementioned Provisional Permit and SLUP issued by the RED, DENR MIMAROPA Region, SEP Clearance No. MODP-122110-001 for Ipilan Nickel Project - Mining Operation and Development issued by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD), Application for Permit to Construct No. 2022-001 purposely for the construction of Causeway/Port Facilities pursuant to PD No. 857 approved on April 5, 2022 by Mr. Elizalde M. Ulson, Port Manager, Port Management Office – Palawan, Port Area, Puerto Princesa City, Philippine Ports Authority and Letter correspondence dated October 8, 2010 addressed to Mr. Ken Stein, Chief Operating Officer of Ipilan Nickel Corporation from OIC-Director Atty. Juan Miguel T. Cuna, DENR-EMB Central Office regarding Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) Ref. No. 1006-0017 granted for Ipilan Nickel Project. Said ECC was cancelled on December 16, 2016 but reinstated on June 5, 2020. Report relative to the said inspection and verification conducted by this Office had been submitted to the Regional Office, MIMAROPA Region thru the PENRO Palawan per Memorandum dated September 14, 2022. It is also informed that the complainant, Mr. Jonathan Miano, Jr. (jbmjr243@gmail.com) had been informed in writing dated September 13, 2022 of the results and findings of the Investigating Team copy furnished thru email the Presidential Complaint Center (PCC) – ppc@malacañang.gov.ph, MGB-MIMAROPA – Mines_4b@yahoo.com, osec@denr.gov.ph and emb.gob.ph.

In view of the foregoing, this Office will conduct regular inspection and monitoring to ensure that the terms and conditions stipulated on the issued Provisional Permit and SLUP are met conscientiously and strictly complied with by the Permittee subject to existing laws, rules and regulations.

ADDITIONAL TERMS, CONDITIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS

1. The area granted in this Permit: (a) is a public forest land based on existing records; (b) shall not be used as security for any indebtedness of the **Permittee**, neither shall be involved in any private transaction.
2. The **Permittee** shall: (a) comply with the laws, rules and regulations and instructions now or hereinafter enforce for the proper use of the land; (b) respect any legal or prior claims by settlement or occupation within the area granted; (c) conserve the corners and boundary lines of the area; (d) protect any spring, waterfalls or natural/historical/archaeological sites in the area; (e) report to the nearest local forest officer(s) all forest violations in the area and adjacent lands; and (f) report to the concerned Regional Executive Director thru channels every six (6) months the kind, number and value of improvement(s) introduced in the area.
3. The **Permittee** shall: (a) not appropriate for himself the exclusive use of public trails traversing or adjoining the area or impede the use thereof by the public; (b) not sublease the area or any portion thereof; and (c) protect and conserve unique, rare and endangered tree/plants/wildlife identified under existing rules and regulations.
4. No trees, regardless of species, shall be cut in the permit area if found within twenty (20) meters from banks of rivers, creeks or streams and of public roads. In case the said 20-meter strip is bereft of trees, the same shall be rehabilitated by the **Permittee**.
