We are requesting the technical assistance of Ecosystems Research Development Bureau on the conduct of Participatory Coastal Resource Assessment (PCRA) in Sibuyan Island, Romblon as one of the activities in Technical Assistance to LGU on other Coastal and Marine Concerns per WFP-2023 under Coastal and Marine Ecosystems Rehabilitation Sub-program.

The PCRA is a critical component of our ongoing efforts to conserve and manage the coastal resources in Sibuyan Island. Our Office is deeply concerned about environmental issue in Sibuyan Island and its potential impacts on the island's mangrove, seagrass and coral resources.

In view of the above concern, we believe that conducting a PCRA would be an important step in understanding the status and health of these coastal resources and in developing a plan for their protection and management. The objective of PCRA is to assess the mangrove, seagrass and coral resources in Sibuyan Island, Romblon, and to provide a basis for informed decision-making with respect to the environmental issue.

The PCRA is scheduled to take place from March 6, 2023 and to end on March 12, 2023. The estimated duration of the technical assistance is seven (7) days.
