



REPORT OF THE CONDUCTED LECTURE ON THE RA 9003 OR THE ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT OF 2000

In consonance with the celebration of the National Zero Waste Month 2023 with the theme, "Stepping Up Solid Waste Management through Efficient Extended Producer's Responsibility", CENRO San Jose through its information conducted lecture on the salient features of the Republic Act 9003 also known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 as well as the role of the youth sector in campaigning for the observance of the best practices in managing the solid wastes generated within communities. The lecture was held in this Office on January 7, 2022.

It was attended by CENRO San Jose partner volunteers including the Supreme Student Government of Occidental Mindoro State College (SSG-OMSC) and the Dagyaw- Tayo Ang Kalikasan ENR Ambassadors. The activity was opened with a prayer and introduction of participants. Afterwards, a message was given by CENR Officer Efren L. delos Reyes expressing his gratitude towards the youth volunteers for giving their time and efforts partnering with this Office. CENRO shared his insights about the role of youth in mitigating climate change. He discussed briefly the causes of climate change, its impacts and relevance of the ecosystems-based approach in developing community's resiliency and adaptive capacity.
