REPORT OF THE CONDUCTED LECTURE ON THE RA 9003 OR THE ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT OF 2000

In consonance with the celebration of the National Zero Waste Month 2023 with the theme, “Stepping Up Solid Waste Management through Efficient Extended Producer’s Responsibility”, CENRO San Jose through its information conducted lecture on the salient features of the Republic Act 9003 also known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 as well as the role of the youth sector in campaigning for the observance of the best practices in managing the solid wastes generated within communities. The lecture was held in this Office on January 7, 2022.

It was attended by CENRO San Jose partner volunteers including the Supreme Student Government of Occidental Mindoro State College (SSG-OMSC) and the Dagyaw- Tayo Ang Kalikasan ENR Ambassadors. The activity was opened with a prayer and introduction of participants. Afterwards, a message was given by CENR Officer Efren L. delos Reyes expressing his gratitude towards the youth volunteers for giving their time and efforts partnering with this Office. CENRO shared his insights about the role of youth in mitigating climate change. He discussed briefly the causes of climate change, its impacts and relevance of the ecosystems-based approach in developing community’s resiliency and adaptive capacity. After the short discussion, the activity immediately proceeded with the lecture proper.

Planning and drafting of modules and set of activities re: Ecological Solid Waste Management.	<p>The activity was done in preparation for the implementation of the KaLIKHAsan project in Brgy. Salvacion, Rizal. The modules and activities formulated by the Dagyaw TAK ENR Ambassadors were presented to CENRO Efren L. delos Reyes, the undersigned and MENRO Louderick Jimena for comments and finalization.</p> <p>During the activity, project brief was also finalized in time for the presentation on the agreed schedule of the proponents and other partners for the proposal's approval.</p>	<p>It is expected that the KaLIKHAsan project be approved by the barangay Council especially the Salvacion Elementary School teaching force headed by their principal- Ms. Garma once presented and discussed on the scheduled project presentation and meeting on January 10, 2022.</p> <p>Upon approval, it is also expected to finally implement the modules and topics as follows: 1) Solid Waste and its management; 2) The different types of solid wastes; and 3) The negative impacts of improper solid waste disposal.</p>

The above-mentioned activities were conducted in preparation for the implementation of different environmental programs and initiatives of this Office in partnership with the Local Government Units, Barangay LGUs, Volunteer organizations and other Offices and stakeholders. These also aim to provide the municipalities within the administrative jurisdiction of CENRO San Jose the technical assistance they need in implementing the relevant provisions of the ESWM Act and its implementing rules and regulations.

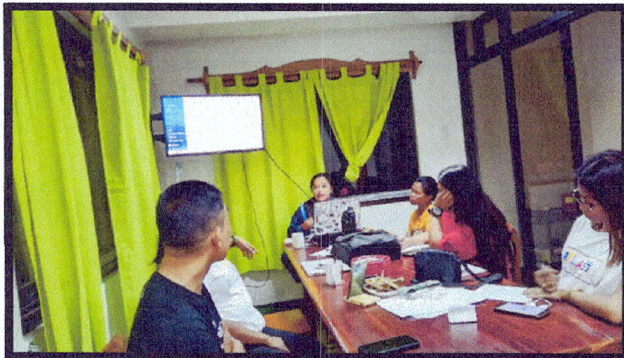
