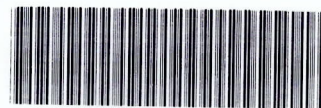

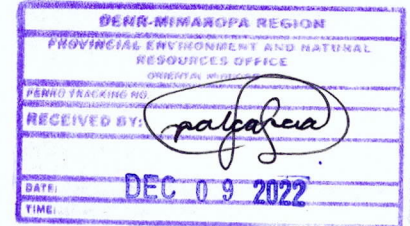

We are pleased to submit the report on the conducted joint checkpoint operation once a week from November 17, 2022 to December 1, 2022. The checkpoint operation was done together with the members of Oriental Mindoro Sagip Kalikasan (SAKAL) Task Force along Nautical High ways in Baco and Socorro, Oriental Mindoro. The Task Force is continuously monitoring the transport of illegal forest products, wildlife and or mineral resources within our area of jurisdiction.

Please be informed that the team visually inspected/checked the cargo/load of trucks, close van and other vehicles for any illegal forest products. Insofar as the activity is concerned, there were no vehicles were checked loaded with illegal forest products. We likewise checked and verified vehicles loaded with lumbers from the southern municipalities under the jurisdiction of CENRO Roxas and found out that they are covered with necessary permits. Nonetheless, we also encountered trucks loaded with sand, gravel and boulders without necessary delivery receipt. The PNP held in abeyance the three (3) trucks until such time they produced their delivery receipt ascribed by the Provincial Government Environment and Natural Resources Office (PG-ENRO).

Please be informed that on November 17, 2022 at 10:00 PM to 12:00 AM, personnel of Monitoring and Enforcement Section (MES) team I led by Forester II Leonida Mindaros together with Forester I Kevin Corpuz, Forest Ranger Reynaldo Ila, Forest Ranger Rhona Liwag, Forest Ranger Norman Asi, Forest Ranger Herrick Jurado, Forest Ranger Armando Cabungcal and Forest Ranger Reyamar Gunday conducted joint checkpoint operation along the nautical highway at Brgy. Batong Dalig, Socorro together with 1st Police Mobile Force Company (PMFC) under the supervision of Force Commander, PLTCOL Remegio D Yapes and 2nd platoon commander led by PLT Julian L Cuarteros Jr and team PSSG Diego R Cabrera, PCPL Mark Alvin Manlolo, PAT JC Bernard Veraque, PAT Benjamin Manalo, PAT John Kenneth Manzano, PAT Edsel Naling and PAT Mark Arjel Manalo.

The team visually inspected/checked the cargo/load of trucks, close van and other vehicles for any illegal forest products. For that moment, there were no vehicles were checked loaded with illegal forest products but we checked and verified vehicles loaded with lumbers with necessary permits issued by CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro.

Another joint checkpoint operation was conducted on December 1, 2022 at 2:00-4:00 PM along the Nautical High way of Baco, Oriental Mindoro by the team 2 led by Chief MES, Ricardo Natividad together with Forester II Leonida Mindaros, Forest Ranger Arnaldo Pudiquet, Forest Ranger Elcid Montero, Forest Ranger Julius Fontanilla, Forest Ranger Adrean Castillo, Forest Ranger Erwin Val Sixon with the assistance of Municipal Police Station (MPS) of Baco led by COP, PCPT Ermin C Cabanding and team PSMS Enrique Fabian, PSMS Reden P Duenas, PSSg Adonis Lopez, PCpl Rodel P Mantuano, PCpl Christopher Troy Gabriel, Pat Russell J C Bautista and Pat Francis Manuel Vesorde. MENRO Minie Hussain and MENRO staff RhaiLyn Pabilando also join the team.

The team visually inspected/checked the cargo/load of trucks, close van and other vehicles for any illegal forest products. For that moment, there were no vehicles were checked loaded with illegal forest products except for trucks loaded with sand, gravel and boulders. There were three (3) trucks intercepted without delivery receipt. According to the driver, they forgot to secure from the Provincial checker. The PNP holds the 3 trucks until such time they produced their delivery receipt.

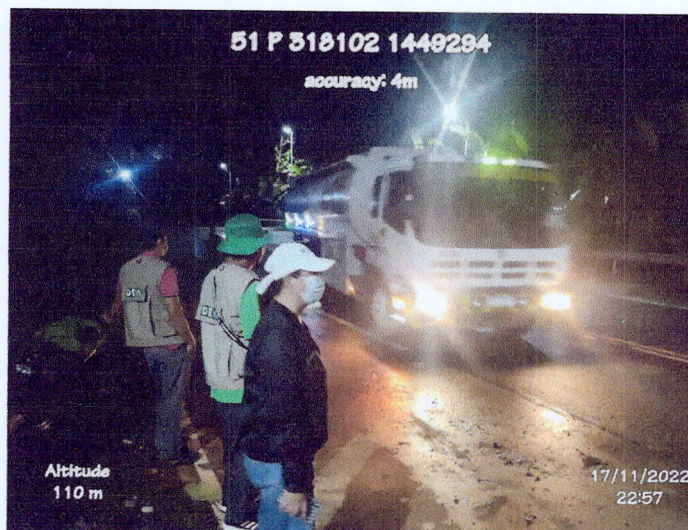
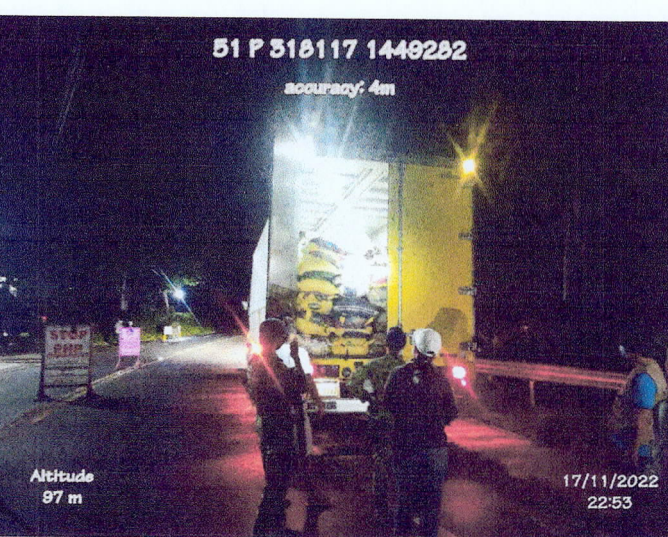
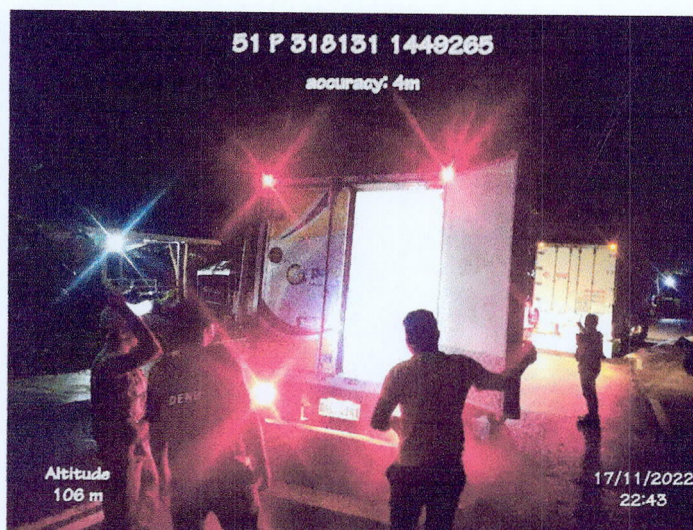
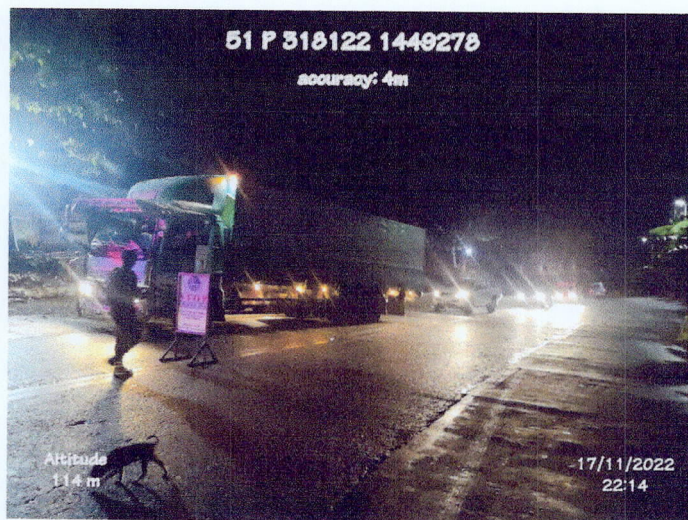
