

MONITORING CONDUCTED WITH CENTRAL OFFICE PERSONNEL

Last November 11, 2022 Forest Ranger Lucelle B. Casticimo of CENRO San Jose accompanied some personnel from the DENR Central Office and the DENR PENRO Occidental Mindoro, on their validation of the Catburan Cave in Sitio Catburan, Brgy. Batasan, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro. The said personnel were Forester Marjorie Manipol and Park Maintenance Foreman Noriel Dulatre, and also joining were Mines and Geosciences Bureau Staff Jebiela Carla Petalcorin, CENRO San Jose GAD Staff Terenst Marie Pineda and Forester Eric Orpilla from the PENR Office.

The P/A/Ps under Management of Caves and Cave Resources are PBB-based targets and table validation of Means of Verification (MOVs and related documents) as well as visit to the site location was done. The team also proceeded to monitor other projects within the area which are the 1) established ENGP Forest Nursery in Brgy. Batasan, and the 2) Monitoring Station in Brgy. Murtha.

Excavation inside the cave was however, noticeably deeper, and is suggesting of continuous Guano collection by unidentified individuals. The guides from the Barangay refuted this and stated that there have been no reports of unknown persons entering the cave without notice from the Barangay.




