

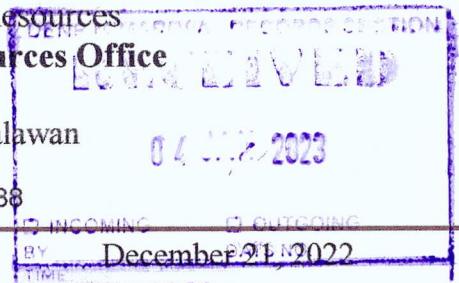

The 4th PAMB Enbanc meeting was conducted on November 24, 2022 at Balai Emma Resort, Narra, Palawan and via zoom.

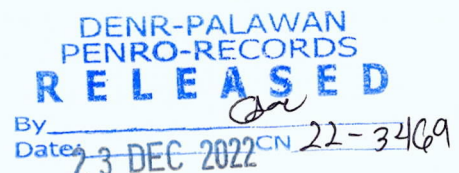

1 **MEETING PROPER**

2 **I. PRELIMINARIES**

3 The meeting started at 10:33 in the morning with an opening prayer led by Ms. Hannah
4 Faith Navarro of Palawan State University (PSU) followed by the singing of the National anthem,
5 the DENR and Narra Hymn.

6 Before the meeting was properly started the head secretariat friendly reminded the board
7 that the current organizational structure will be recognized until such time that the Manual of
8 Operation (MOO) is not yet revised since the restructuring of PAMB members is included in the
9 revision of MOO.

10 **II. DETERMINATION OF QUORUM AND CALL TO ORDER**

11 Before the meeting, the head secretariat suggested to nominate a Presiding Chair among
12 the regular members who attended, since the DENR Region IV-B Regional Executive Director, as
13 the PAMB Chairperson of the board was absent. Mr. Aguilardo Deig of Sagip Katala Movement
14 nominated Police MAJOR Roel A. Tattao of MPS-PNP, Narra as the presiding chair and duly
15 seconded by Dr. Lita B. Sopsop of Western Philippines University (WPU). The board concurred
16 to the nomination, PMAJOR Tattao presided over the meeting.

17 The secretariat read and acknowledged the fourteen (14) attending PAMB members, nine
18 (9) attended face-to-face and five (5) via zoom. The number of attendees comprises the quorum
19 (50+1), hence, the presiding chair declared a quorum.

20 III. READING AND DISPOSITION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES OF MEETING

21 The secretariat presented the minutes of 2nd PAMB en banc meeting held on July 22, 2022, at
22 Sunlight Hotel, Puerto Princesa City.

23 Mr. Jemson Cervancia asked regarding the process for securing the visit to Rasa Island. The
24 secretariat answered that the Protected Area Management Office needs to fill-out a registration
25 form, vaccination card and certain fees for the visit to the Island.

26 Dr. Sopsop suggested to approve the current disposed minutes first before the reading and
27 disposition of the other minutes of the meeting. Hon. Rolando Magura of Barangay Antipuluan
28 moved the motion for the approval of the 2nd PAMB en banc meeting and duly seconded by Dr.
29 Sopsop. The 2nd PAMB en banc minutes of meeting was approved subject for insertion of the
30 comments, reviews, and grammatical corrections of the PAMB members.

31 The attending members and representatives asked for the updates regarding the matters and
32 concerns that were discussed during the 2nd en banc meeting. The secretariat answered that most
33 of the matters were already accomplished. According to the secretariat, the PAMO was already
34 collected and forwarded to the Regional Office the TNA questionnaire that was answered by the
35 members. The revised PDS form was already sent to the members but there was no feedback. The
36 office was already communicated to the mayor's office regarding the foreword and until today it's
37 not yet submitted. The PAMO staff always went into the Mayor's office to follow up but most of
38 the time the Hon. Mayor Gerandy B. Danao was on travel and sometimes he had a meeting. But
39 according with Ms. Bautista, secretary of the Municipal Mayor, the foreword was already finished.
40 The PAMB Resolution No. 2022-02: RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE ADOPTION OF THE
41 ILLEGAL, UNREPORTED AND UNREGULATED (IUU) FISHING INDEX AND THREAT
42 ASSESSMENT TOOL (I-FIT) TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) OF NARRA,
43 PALAWAN AND FURTHER ENDORSING THE SAID I-FIT TOOL TO BE INTEGRATED
44 IN THE MUNICIPALITY'S ANNUAL INVESTMENT PLAN FOR ITS SUSTAINED
45 IMPLEMENTATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY, was already approved and waiting for the
46 approved minutes of the 2nd PAMB en banc meeting before forwarding to the Regional Office for
47 affirmation of the PAMB Chair. The draft PA bill is still withheld since the PAMO had received
48 a Memorandum from PENRO instructing to submit the CSW in order for the Regional Office to
49 review if PA-RIWS need to conduct re-PASA. The online registration for the visitors of Rasa was
50 not yet created since the office is not authorized to create an online/website page. PENRO
51 Felizardo B. Cayatoc suggested to coordinate with Ms. Beth Maclang of PPUR for the process
52 and requirements in creating the website page. He added that it needs a clearance from the DENR.

53 The Chair asked the pleasure of the body regarding the deadline for the submission of the
54 revised PDS form and the insertions and comments of approved 2nd PAMB en banc minutes for
55 submission to the PAMO. Dr. Sopsop suggested that within this week, however, the secretariat
56 must send the copy to all members. The members concurred with Dr. Lita's suggestion.

57 Before the meeting proceeded to the next topic, the secretariat welcomed the PENRO and the
58 current OIC, CENRO of the office. PENRO Cayatoc and OIC, CENRO Renato S. Gonzaga gave
59 their messages to the members of PAMB as they are thankful and very much appreciated for their
60 support to the PAMO and the protected area as well.

61 The secretariat presented the minutes of the 3rd PAMB en banc meeting held on September 15,
62 2022, at Balai Emma Resort, Narra, Palawan.

63 The members commented to change some grammatical words and phrases that were used in
64 the minutes.

65 Engr. Dennis Billones asked if there was a resolution that was approved upon the creation of
66 the Technical Working Group (TWG). The secretariat answered that there was no approved
67 resolution since it was decided during the 3rd en banc meeting that the resolution will come-up after
68 the revision of the MOO. Hon. Ramel Dicar asked if the barangay has a share in the collection of
69 the PA-RIWS visitors. The secretariat answered based on the Technical Bulletin that 75% percent
70 of the revenue of the PA shall be retained and deposited in the authorized government depository
71 bank as PA retention income account and the 25% of the revenue shall be deposited as IPAF special
72 account in the general fund to the revenue of treasury. The IPAF shall be used solely for the
73 protection, maintenance, restoration, and management of the PA.

74 Since there was no other issue raised, therefore the Presiding Chair asked for motion for the
75 approval of the minutes of the 3rd PAMB en banc meeting. Dr. Sopsop moved the motion for the
76 approval of the minutes of the 3rd PAMB en banc meeting including the corrections and duly
77 seconded by Engr. Dennis Billones of MPDO.

78 The meeting was paused for lunch break at 12:38 in the afternoon.

79 The meeting resumed at 1:33 in the afternoon.

80 The secretariat presented the minutes of the Special Committee meeting held on July 22, 2022,
81 via Zoom.

82 The members commented to change some grammatical words and phrases that were used in
83 the minutes.

84 There were no further issues and concerns that were raised, the Chair called for the approval of
85 the minutes of the Special committee meeting.

86 Engr. Billones moved the motion for the approval of the minutes of the Special Committee
87 meeting and duly seconded by Dr. Sopsop

88 **IV. BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES OF MEETING**

89 Ms. Agullo asked regarding the restructuring of PAMB members whereas, based on the
90 minutes of the special committee meeting, it was agreed to discuss this matter in the en banc
91 meeting. PASu Ma. Teresa V. Ayson answered that this matter was not included in this meeting
92 agenda since this matter will also be discussed in the revision of the MOO, she also clarified that
93 the regular member will be the one to approve the revised MOO and that would possibly be on the
94 1st en banc of FY 2023. Mr. Noli Dieron of MAO BFAR suggested to emphasize this matter to the
95 regular members that they must attend personally in the next en banc meeting so that this issue
96 could be discussed and approved to avoid deferment and moving again and again in the next en
97 banc meeting. The secretariat concurred with Mr. Dieron's suggestion.

98 **V. APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

99 Dr. Sopsop commented regarding the inclusion of minutes of the previous meeting to the new
100 agenda since the following minutes were already discussed and approved during the reading and
101 disposition of the previous minutes. She suggested to remove the previous minutes from the new
102 agenda only the presentation of the resolution. The members concurred with Dr. Sopsop’s
103 suggestion, and the Chair reiterated the new agenda based on the suggestion of the attended
104 members and representatives.

105 Dr. Sopsop moved the motion for the approval of new agenda including the other matters and
106 duly seconded by Ms. Christina C. Rodriguez of PCSD.

107 **VI. NEW BUSINESS**

108 **A. PAMB RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03 - AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISION OF**
109 **PAMB RESOLUTION NO. 2019-01 RE: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE**
110 **OPENING OF A TRUST ACCOUNT FOR RASA ISLAND WILDLIFE**
111 **SANCTUARY (RIWS) AT LAND BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES, PUERTO**
112 **PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN FOR ITS 75% INCOME PURSUANT TO**
113 **REPUBLIC ACT 10629**

114 The secretariat presented the resolution to the board.

115 Dr. Sopsop asked how the amending resolution incorporated the approved resolution. The
116 secretariat answered that the amended resolution will be attached to the approved resolution. Dr.
117 Sopsop concurred.

118 Ms. Navarro moved the motion for the approval of PAMB Resolution No. 2022-03 and duly
119 seconded by Hon. Ramel Dicar of Bgy. Panacan II.

120 **B. NYOFEC RESIGNATION LETTER AS RIWS PAMB MEMBER**

121 The secretariat presented the resignation letter of the president of the NYOFEC.

122 The members discussed the resignation of the NYOFEC as PAMB member. They discussed
123 whether to accept the resignation or give the organization another chance to comply with the
124 accreditation. In the end, they decided and agreed to defer and the final action should be on the
125 board.

126 Ms. Agullo moved the motion to defer the action regarding this agenda subject to refer the
127 discussion of this matter in the next en banc meeting and duly seconded by Mr. Dieron.

128 **C. COLLECTION OF FEES FOR RIWS TOURISM**

129 Ms. Agullo moved the motion to defer this agenda subject for discussion in the Resource
130 Mobilization Committee and duly seconded by Dr. Sopsop.

D. RESOLUTION NO. 004 SERIES OF 2022: A RESOLUTION TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT, OBSERVE, AND PRACTICE PROPER SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND DISCOURAGE THE TRANSPORTATION AND USE OF SINGLE-USE PLASTIC PRODUCTS WITHIN THE PROTECTED AREA RASA ISLAND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

The secretariat presented the draft PAMB Resolution No. 04 series of 2022.

Ms. Agullo suggested that this matter should be discussed in another committee meeting. Dr. Sopsop concurred to Ms. Agullo's suggestion and added to refer this matter to the Research Committee. PASu Ma. Teresa V. Ayson clarified to the board if they could possibly approve this resolution during the session to comply with the target of PAMO before December 15, 2022. She added that the approved resolution will be supplemented by approved minutes. Ms. Agullo asked if this was plausible since the 4th en banc minutes of meeting will be approved during the 1st en banc meeting of the succeeding year. Dr. Sopsop suggested to have special PAMB en banc meeting for the approval of minutes of the 4th PAMB en banc meeting so that the PAMO could comply with their targets. The secretariat concurred to Dr. Sopsop's suggestion.

The chair asked for a possible date of committee meeting before the conduct of special en banc to discuss the matter of approval of PAMB resolution No. 04. Dr. Sopsop suggested November 29, 2022 @ 1pm via zoom, but Engr. Billones suggested that the Resolution No. 4 should be discussed in the special PAMB en banc instead of the committee to save time. The members concurred with his suggestion. Ms. Navarro moved the motion to conduct the special en banc meeting on November 29, 2022, provided that draft minutes should be circulated to the regular members before the special meeting and duly seconded by Dr. Sopsop.

RESOLUTION NO. 004 Series of 2022

A RESOLUTION TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT, OBSERVE, AND PRACTICE PROPER SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND DISCOURAGE THE TRANSPORTATION AND USE OF SINGLE-USE PLASTIC PRODUCTS WITHIN THE PROTECTED AREA-RASA ISLAND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

WHEREAS, Rasa Island was declared as Wildlife Sanctuary last February 15, 2006 by virtue of Presidential Proclamation 1000 Pursuant to the Republic Act 7586 as amended by RA 11038 known as Expanded National Integrated Protected Area (ENIPAS) Act of 2018;

WHEREAS, the RIWS Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) was created as the sole-policy making body of the Rasa Island Sanctuary as mandated in Presidential Proclamation No. 1000, and pursuant to the provision of the Expanded National Integrated Protected Areas System Act of 2018;

WHEREAS, significant part of the Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary is a Marine Protected Area with rich and marine biodiversity (species and ecosystems) that conservation and protection is strictly enforced;

WHEREAS, the Republic Act 9003 known as Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 and RA 11038 ENIPAS Act of 2018 shall be strictly implemented, observed and practiced within the Protected Area;

WHEREAS, the visitors/tourists and any person(s) visiting Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary shall be strictly prohibited to dumping, littering and leave their trash in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary and transportation and use of single-use plastic products shall likewise be discouraged;

WHEREAS, the single-use plastic products that shall be prohibited in the PA-RIWS include but are not limited to plastic bags, straws, coffee stirrers, soda and water bottles, disposable utensils, wet wipes, cigarette butts, and most food packaging that are disposable in nature but are non-biodegradable;

WHEREAS, the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) shall be responsible for the orientation of the visitors/tourists relative to the policy, rules, and regulation and post the herein resolution at the Wardens/Rangers camp for the information and awareness of all visitors;

WHEREAS, the Enforcement Committee and the PAMO shall oversee for the strict implementation of RA 9003 and herein resolution in coordination with the Local Government Unit of Narra, Palawan as the primary responsible agency for the implementation and enforcement of RA 9003 pursuant to Section 10 of Local Government Code of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, any person committed violation shall subject to a penalty pursuant to section 20 f and l of RA 11038 or ENIPAS Act.

NOW THEREFORE, in motion of Hon. Don Veneranda seconded by Ms. Sheila S. Nalda, be it;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to pass “A RESOLUTION TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT, OBSERVE, AND PRACTICE PROPER SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND DISCOURAGE THE TRANSPORTATION AND USE OF SINGLE-USE PLASTIC PRODUCTS WITHIN THE PROTECTED AREA-RASA ISLAND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY”

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this approved resolution be furnished to the Office of the Local Government Unit and Municipal Tourism Office of Narra, Palawan for information and reference.


