REGARDING ONE DEAD TAMARAW FOUND WITHIN

MTS. IGLIT-BACO NATURAL PARK (MIBNP)

Forwarded is the memorandum dated December 7, 2022 of Assistant PASu of Mounts Iglit-Baco Natural Park (MIBNP) regarding submission of the corrected spot report regarding one (1) dead Tamaraw found within Mounts Iglit-Baco Natural Park (MIBNP) on March 3, 2022. Please be informed that the dead tamaraw was found approximately 100 meters away from Magawang Station and 5 meters away from foot trail going to Station 2 with geographical coordinates 12°420N, 121°4'4'E.

Based on the report, the tamaraw is male approximately 19-20 years old and may have died as a result of bullfighting due to serious injuries, including two holes caused possibly by another male Tamaraw's horn.

REGARDING ONE DEAD TAMARAW FOUND WITHIN

MTS. IGLIT-BACO NATURAL PARK (MIBNP)

Respectfully submitted herewith the corrected spot report regarding one (1) Tamaraw found dead in Tamaraw Core Habitat within Mts. Iglit-Baco Natural Park (MIBNP) on March 3, 2022. The dead tamaraw was found approximately 100 meters away from Magawang Station and 5 meters away from foot trail going to Station 2 with geographical coordinates 12°420N, 121°4′4′E.

The MIBNP-PAMO field personnel found that the dead Tamaraw was male and approximately 19-20 years old and may have died as a result of bullfighting. The body of the Tamaraw clearly indicates serious injuries, including two holes caused possibly by another male Tamaraw's horn.

SUBJECT

ONE TAMARAW FOUND DEAD AT THE TAMARAW

CORE HABITAT IN MTS. IGLIT-BACO NATURAL PARK

Please be informed that the PAMO team conducted patrolling and monitoring inside the Tamaraw core habitat in Mts. Iglit-Baco Natural Park on March 3, 2022. At around 5:08 in the afternoon, the team found one (1) dead Tamaraw approximately 100 meters away from Magawang Station and 5 meters along the foot trail with coordinates 12°420N, 121°4'4'E. In our observation it was dead a day ago. It is a male Tamaraw with an estimated age of 19-20 years old.

The cause of death of the Tamaraw was because of Bull Fighting. It has a wound from stricken horn at the part of the neck and the back part of the thigh. The team made a 2 meters length x 1 meter width and 1.5 meters deep hole to bury the dead Tamaraw. The team made a spot report and submitted it to the head of the Office.
