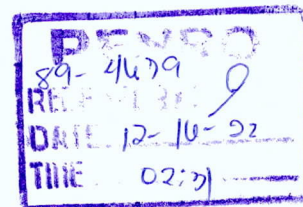
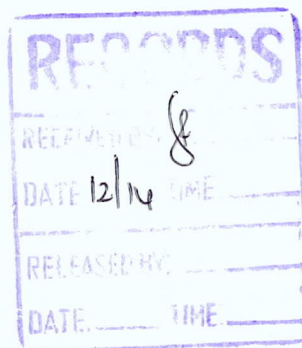

72 present, hence there is a quorum.

74 **2. Call to Order**

76 Pursuant to BMB Technical Bulletin No. 2017 – 04, PAMB Algene Edward  
77 Francisco was chosen to preside over the meeting on motion of PAMB Fernando  
78 Dalangin and seconded by PAMB David David, with concurrence of the body.

80 **3. Review of the Minutes of Previous Meeting**

82 PASu Villanada explained that the previous meeting conducted last July 26, 2022 was  
83 already approved by the Regional Executive Director.

85 **4. Presentation and Approval of the Provisional Agenda**

100 PASu Villanada informed the board that the presenter from UPLB were not able to  
101 attend the meeting and present their project proposal due to conflict of schedule,  
102 therefore agenda number 1 and 4 were cancelled as well as the agenda number 3.

The body agreed that any topics not included in the lists of the provisional agenda shall fall on "Other Matters".

#### 4. New Business

##### **COLLECTION OF DERIVATIVES (BONES, SEEDS, FEATHERS, ETC.) FOR THE MINDORO BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION CENTER.**

PAMB Francisco welcomed the representatives from Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Foundation, Inc. He informed the board that the MBCFI would present their proposal regarding the collection of specimen in ARNP.

Ms. Kyle Cielo of MBCFI said that their goals are to continue their mission in conserving Mindoro's diverse but threatened biodiversity. She added that MBCFI envisioned that their priority thrust would be effectively achieved through the establishment of Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Center (MBBC). She said that MBCC will provide space for biodiversity collections such as preserves specimen from Mindoro. Ms. Cielo then asked permission from the PAMB to allow their organization to collect specimen in the protected area. She further explained that the collections do not have to be new or live specimen but also derivatives like bones, seeds, or feathers that are possibly available in the area. She also presented the biodiversity center and parts of the museum storyline.

PAMB David asked the presenter if they will only gathering their data / specimen on the terrestrial.

Ms. Cielo said that they will also collect and exhibit aquatic fishes and other marine species in partnership with the UPMSI.

PASu Villanada informed the presenter and the PAMB that they have available specimens of brown boobies and carapace of marine turtle.

PAMB Rodil stated that all their activities must be done accordingly with the rules and restrictions being implemented in the protected area. He added that some researchers and institutions are simply using their research and projects as an excuse to obtain data from Apo Reef.

PASu Villanada assured that the MBCFI will observe all the rules and restrictions of the protected area. Inclusion to the upcoming conservation center is a good opportunity for the promotion of Apo Reef Natural Park. She added that results from previously conducted researches and studies were submitted and consolidated wherein the PAMO and the PAMB used as a reference for management strategies. She also enlightened the board that MBCFI has been assisting them over the years, especially in the annual bird survey.

PAMB Francisco asked Ms. Cielo regarding the schedule of the collection of specimen.

Ms. Cielo said that collection of specimen shall start on December 2022 upon the approval of the PAMB.



On motion of PAMB Fernando B. Dalangin, seconded by PAMB David N. David, the board passed a resolution **"ALLOWING THE MINDORO BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION FOUNDATION, INC. TO COLLECT ANIMALS AND PLANT DERIVATIVES FROM APO REEF NATURAL PARK FOR THE MINDORO BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION CENTER (MBCC)"** was passed.

**MANAGEMENT EFFECTIVENESS ASSESSMENT OF APO REEF NATURAL PARK**


PASu Villanada gives a brief report on the result of the management effectiveness assessment of ARNP for the year 2017. She said that as per BMB Technical Bulletin 2018-05, the MEA should be conducted every two (2) years. However, due to the pandemic that we have experienced for the last two (2) years, the PAMO did not manage to implement such activity. She then asked the PAMB to answer the provided assessment form for MEA 2022.

PAMB members together with the secretariat scrutinized the assessment form one by one in order to assess the management of the Protected Area Management Office. The PAMO then collected the forms after the assessment for consolidation. PAMB members that were present via Zoom will submit the accomplished assessment form via email.


**III. Adjournment**

Having no other matters to discuss, PAMB Rodil moved for the adjournment of the meeting seconded by the body. The meeting ended at exactly 12:19 in the afternoon.



**WHEREAS**, the goals of Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Foundation, Inc. is to continue their mission in conserving Mindoro's diverse but threatened biodiversity through the establishment of Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Center (MBCC) located in Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro;

**WHEREAS**, the objective of MBCC is to provide space for biodiversity collection such as preserved specimen from Mindoro;

**WHEREAS**, the specimens will be housed in the natural history museum of the center together with the paintings, drawings, photographs, other art and exhibit regarding biodiversity;

**WHEREAS**, the Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Foundation, Inc. are seeking for permission from the ARNP-PAMB to allow them to collect animal and plant derivatives from Apo Reef Natural Park;

**WHEREAS**, the Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Foundation, Inc. (MBCFI) guaranteed the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) and the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) that the collection do not have to be new or live specimens but also derivatives such as bones, seeds, feather, etc. that are possible available in the protected area;


**WHEREFORE**, premises considered and after due deliberation and upon motion of PAMB Fernando B. Dalangin, duly seconded by PAMB David N. David, the ARNP-PAMB **ALLOW** as it is hereby **ALLOWED** to **THE MINDORO BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION FOUNDATION, INC. TO COLLECT ANIMAL AND PLANT DERIVATIVES FROM APO REEF NATURAL PARK FOR THE MINDORO BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION CENTER**, providing that the entity shall act accordingly to the rules and restrictions agreed by the Protected Area Management Board and being implemented by the Protected Area Management Office.
