TO LAWIN ACTIVITIES

This pertains to our target this year under LAWIN in the Work and Financial Plan for climate-responsive output within the jurisdiction.

As our **Means of Verification** (MoV) in this activity which categorizes a submission of report, please be informed of the following climate-responsive output of our staff:

- 1. Our LAWIN patrollers are on regular patrolling over the conservation areas with 883 kilometers or equivalent to 88,300 hectares of forest and mangrove area monitored and protected.
- 2. The conservation areas include some NGP sites, mangrove cover, closed and open forest.
- 3. The establishment of NGP plantation including the maintenance and protection over the previous years established plantation within the conservation area is a climate–responsive output especially the greening rehabilitation in the reported trees cutting was reported as a threat on LAWIN patrolling.

For the year, records show that there were about eight thousand (8,000) mangrove propagules planted in the various tree planting activities whether spearheaded by the Office or by other environmental advocating groups. The figure is apart from other seedlings planted like narra. While not included as an activity under LAWIN, patrollers also participated in coastal and river, estero clean-up activities which is another climate responsive output.

Attached is the map showing the patrol route within and outside the Conservation Area including the NGP and CBFM areas.
