This pertains to the target activity on Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) under Protected Area Management and Development Sub Program for El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected Area (ENTMRPA), El Nido, Palawan.

Please be informed that this Office has produced four (4) copies of photo checklist of flora and fauna of ENTMRPA and included the description of each species. A total of thirty-five (35) flora species and thirty-three (33) fauna species is featured in the checklist based on the result of 2006 terrestrial and coastal and marine surveys. Other data was also integrated in the photo checklist based on the previous assessment conducted for Biodiversity Assessment and Monitoring System (BAMS) within the protected area. Several species are endemic in Palawan and also classified as threatened.

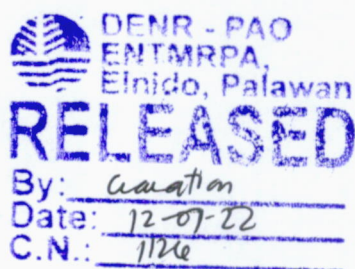

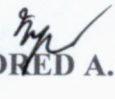
