

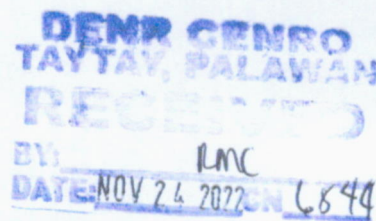


SUBJECT : **REQUEST FOR REASSIGNMENT FROM REGULATION AND
