MINUTES OF MEETING
INFORMATION, EDUCATION AND COMMUNICATION (IEC) CAMPAIGN
Municipality of Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro
December 13, 2022

On December 13, 2022 at Muelle Puerto Galera Pier, Province of Oriental Mindoro, the CENRO Socorro Regulation and Permitting Section spearheaded by Land Management Officer III Maria Alva Renelyn A. Culla-Umali conducted an Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Campaign. This is an initiative to facilitate the implementation of Green Economy Model (GEM) Activity in Puerto Galera, this activity aims to impart suitable knowledge in conservation, protection, and to contribute in the rehabilitation of degraded ecosystems. The said activity was participated by the Municipal Officials of Puerto Galera, Barangay Chairpersons, CENRO Socorro personnel and other concerned offices.

Land Management Inspector I Hazel Marie F. Ferras facilitated the event. It formally started with a prayer led by Special Investigator Walter L. Tolentino and singing of the national anthem. LMI I Ferras for the acknowledged all participants and a warm welcome remarks was rendered by Hon. Aristeo Villamor R. Atienza II of Brgy. Poblacion. LMO Umali cited the purpose of the activity and enumerated the topics to be discussed:

- *Legal Easement*
- *Foreshore Areas*
- *Article 51, Presidential Decree no. 1507 (Water Code of the Philippines)*
- *DAO 97-05*
- *RA 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2001)*
- *Republic Act No. 7942 (Philippine Mining Act of 1995)*
- *DAO 2021-11 and DAO 2020-18*

Legal Easement, Foreshore Areas, and Article 51, Presidential Decree no. 1507 (Water Code of the Philippines) was presented by SI Walter L. Tolentino, the discussion includes the guidelines on the establishment of legal easements, modes of disposition of foreshore lands and requirements for Foreshore Lease Application (FLA).

The second presenter was Forest Technician II Michael Anjelo A. Acuzar, he discussed about the purpose and implementation of DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 1997-05/ Procedure in the Retention of Areas with certain distances along the banks of Rivers, Streams, and Shore of Seas, Lakes and Oceans for Environmental Protection.

The R.A. 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2001) was delivered by Forester I Mackaley P. Martinez, the presenter discussed the proper disposal of solid waste,



and the role of different sectors with regard to Solid Waste Management. Salient features and regulating laws of Republic Act No. 7942 Philippine Mining Act of 1995 were discussed.

Last topic was presented by Forester I Jessilyn S. Villanueva (Head-Forest Utilization Unit), DAO no. 2021-11 also known as Guidelines in the Processing and Issuance of Permits for the Cutting, Removal and Relocation of Naturally Growing Trees and DAO 2020-18 also known as Promoting Tree Plantation Development and Liberalizing Harvesting and Trees Derivatives for inclusive Growth and Sustainable Development. Forester Villanueva discussed the focal point of both DENR Administrative Order and its necessary requirements.

After the presentations, the issues and concerns raised were the following:

- Ano po ang batayan para masabing Urban Area na ang isang lugar? (Brgy. Captain Ramil V. Candava of Balatero)

-Urban Barangay (1) If a barangay has a population size of 5,000 or more, then a barangay is considered urban, or (2) If a barangay has at least one establishment with a minimum of 100 employees, a barangay is considered urban, or (3) If a barangay has 5 or more establishments with a minimum of 10 employees, and 5 or more facilities, then a barangay is considered urban. Note that if the facility is not present in the barangay, presence of facilities within the two kilometer radius from the barangay hall is considered. (<https://psa.gov.ph/content/urban-barangay-1>)

- Nais po naming mabigyang linaw patungkol sa implementasyon ng 20 meters Legal Easement? (Brgy. Captain Melchor F. Jalac of San Antonio)

-Proper implementation of Legal Easement were further explain under DAO 2021-07 or the Guidelines on the establishment of Legal Easements along the Seas, Rivers, Lakes, Esteros, and Creeks. For private properties affected by the implementation, relocation of concrete markings is recommended.

- Nais po naming malaman ang nakapaloob/nilalaman ng Foreshore Lease Contract, parte po ba nito ang pagbabakod at pagbabawal dumaan sa lugar? (Brgy. Captain Melchor F. Jalac of San Antonio)

-There are 3 Foreshore Lease Contract issued within Puerto Galera, namely: 1 Fisherman's Cove 2 Squares Beach Front 3 El Galleon. Foreshore areas are still part of public domain any restriction of access or blockage of the area is not indicated in the contract. Puerto Galera create Foreshore Development and Management Plan for

responsible usage of foreshore areas including the determination of docking areas for boat.

- Gaano po ba katagal ang validity ng cutting permit? (Brgy. Kagawad Jomer B. Cataquis of San Isidro)

-Indicated in DAO 2021-11 also known as "Guidelines in the Processing and Issuance of Permits for the Cutting, Removal and Relocation of Naturally Growing Trees" under Section 7. Duration of the Tree Cutting Permit-the duration of the permit shall be dependent upon the volume granted following the schedule provided below but shall not exceed one (1) year at any one time. The permit shall be immediate and executory upon receipt of the CENRO/ Implementing PENRO and shall automatically expire as soon as the tree/s is/are harvested and disposed of, or once it reaches the end of the validity period, whichever comes first.

301-500 cu. m	6 months


After the open forum, Development Management Officer IV Leo G. Capon give a short message to formally close the activity.
