



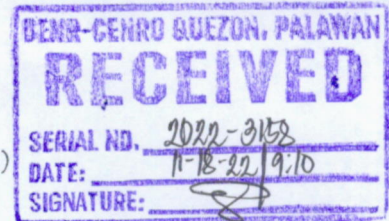

HIGHLIGHTS

Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) seeks to conserve the remaining forest through protection, reforestation of denuded areas, assisted natural regeneration (ANR) of remaining forest, and secure the protection and maintenance of planted trees.

The Forest Protection project also aims to achieve the following:

- (1) Compliance with the JVA requirements;
- (2) Strengthening existing collaboration(s) with the MENRO, PCSD, DENR, Municipal LGU, and Local Government Units (LGU) of Ransang and Candawaga, Rizal and other local communities and partners especially with the protection and reforestation of the denuded forest;
- (3) Supporting the National Greening Program of the Government (NGP);
- (4) Further enhancement of the awareness and capabilities of the local communities in the protection, reforestation of denuded forest and establishment of endemic fruits & trees, and high value fruit tree plantation;
- (5) Effective mobilization of local communities towards the protection of the remaining forest and establishment of high value fruit tree plantation; and
- (6) help improve the living condition of IP's and non-IPs through the promotion of raising the indigenous tree and fruit tree seedlings.




For this month of OCTOBER 2022, the Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) has accomplished the following activities:


- a. Last October 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation continue conducted Plantation Establishment and Development such as land preparation, collection and hauling of stakes and alignment and sticking. The LFPC planters' team were accomplished of collected and hauled of stakes of Three Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty (3,950) pieces and we were accomplished the alignment and sticking of three thousand nine hundred nineteen (3,919) pieces of stake. ***(Please see photos attached as ANNEX A)***
- b. Last October 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation conducted a holing, hauling and planting of seedlings in Sitio Upper Malutok, Ransang, Rizal, Palawan. A total planted of Mahogany (*Swietenia macrophylla*) seedlings is three thousand nine hundred nineteen (3,919) pieces. ***(Please see photos attached as ANNEX B)***
- c. Last October 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation continued conducting the nursery activities and Seedlings Care and Maintenance inside the Forest Tree Nursery area. The following activities in the nursery are soil bagging, transplanting and Collecting of Mahogany (*Swietenia macrophylla*) wildlings. The following activities for care and maintenance of seedlings stocks are application of organic fertilizer, spraying of pest and disease, watering and weeding. A total number of seedlings maintained in the forest tree nursery is Twelve Thousand Six Hundred Four (12,604) pieces. ***(Please see photos attached as ANNEX C)***
- d. Last October 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) workers continued undertaking of seedling production to continue supply the demand of tree plantation. The LFPC nursery workers collected of Mahogany wildlings with a total of Four Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Five (4,585) wildlings and Fifty (50) wildlings of Guyabano. ***(Please see photos attached as ANNEX D)***



- e. Last October 2022, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation's Foot Patrol Unit continued conducting regular on-site monitoring of illegal activities inside the JVA and adjacent areas. And as of this month, there is no trace of Illegal activities such as poachers of wildlife as well as Illegal loggings monitored in the vicinity and neighbors of the Lionheart areas, that's because of the presence of the DENR-CENRO, Quezon, Kilusan Sagip Kalikasan (KSK), Non-Government Organization (NGO) staff, and Barangay Local Government Unit (BLGU) and also the Foot Patrol Unit team of the LFPC. ***(Please see photos attached as ANNEX E)***
