Respectfully forwarded is the Memorandum dated September 2, 2022 from PENRO-Palawan submitting the CSW Report of Land Management Officer III David F. Dalino of PENRO-Palawan in response to the complaint of the Samahan ng mga Magsasaka ng Zigzag, Sta. Lucia, Luzviminda, Puerto Princesa City (SMZSLUPC) addressed to the Office of the President.

Case Background:

Resolution No. 08 2020 was passed by the association requesting before the Office of the President to conduct investigation against Government Officials from the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), DENR-CENRO Puerto Princesa City and Iwahig Penal and Prison Farm (IPPF) relative to the alleged non-compliance of said officials to Executive Order No. 75, "Directing all Departments, Bureaus, Officers and Instrumentalities of the Government to identify lands owned by the government devoted to or suitable for agriculture and for distribution for qualified beneficiaries". Accordingly, members of the SMZSLUPC were supposed to be benefited by the privileges provided under E.O. 75. However, the executive order was not properly implemented as claimed by the people's organization.

Action/s Taken:

A Memorandum dated July 11, 2022 from the Regional Executive Director was sent to PENRO-Palawan with instruction to conduct investigation in coordination with the parties concerned, and to submit CSW report with categorical recommendations.



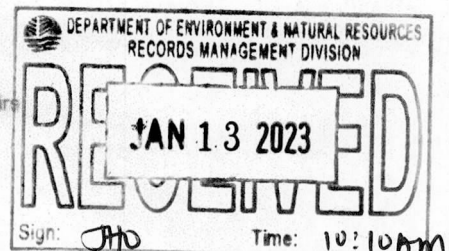

This refers to your Memorandum¹ dated February 16, 2022 regarding the letter request dated January 25, 2022 of National Power Corporation to construct Diesel Power Plants located in the Municipality of Roxas (Green Island), Municipality of Culion (Galoc) and Municipality of Agutaya (Macaranao Island) that fall within timberland, forest land and unclassified public forest.

Based on DENR Administrative Order No. 2004-59, forestlands may be occupied, developed and utilized by a qualified person/s provided that the purpose is deemed necessary and for national interest such as communication station site, energy development site and right-of-way.

However, Section 20 of Presidential Decree No. 705, as amended, states that "No person may utilize, exploit, occupy, possess or conduct any activity within any forest land, xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx, unless he has been authorized to do so under a license, agreement, lease, license or permit".

Lastly, may we remind you to ensure the completeness of all the requirements of any tenurial instrument applications being endorsed to this Office to avoid delay in the processing thereof.

Please find the attached NGP Project DIME shapefiles for the month of May CY 2022 with shapefiles of the three (3) provinces: Oriental Mindoro, Marinduque, and Romblon. Below is the summary of the accomplishments on Project DIME within MIMAROPA Region per province.

Project DIME covered a total of seventeen (17) sites with seven (7) contractors. Areas under third year maintenance and protection are mostly planted with mangrove and bamboo consisting of Nipa (*Nypa fruticans*) and Kawayan Tinik (*Bambusa blumeana*). On the other hand, areas under the second year maintenance and protection consists of bamboo, high value crops, fruit trees, and forest trees including indigenous species such as Coffee (*Coffea arabica*), Cacao (*Theobroma cacao*) and Guyabano (*Annona muricata*) trees.

Under the jurisdiction of CENRO Roxas, Oriental Mindoro, a total number of 65 sites were planted with bamboo, indigenous trees, and other fruit trees involving 62 contractors. As shown the table above, these areas are currently undergoing second year maintenance and protection accomplishing a total of 372.63 hectares, 8% larger than the target area. Yielding a percentage over a total accomplishment of 24.21%.

PENRO Romblon accomplished 222.18 hectares over 220 hectares target area implemented by administration covering 41 Project DIME sites. Under second year maintenance and protection, and CO-based Bamboo Plantations Project, 201.18 and 21 hectares have been accomplished, respectively.

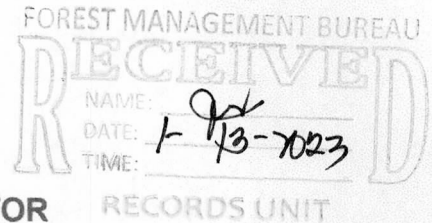

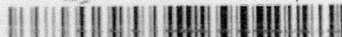


This refers to your Memorandum dated August 23, 2022 regarding the above mentioned subject.

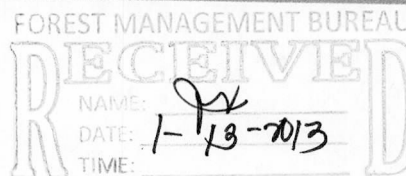

This office respectfully submits the NGP Project DIME Report as of August 2022, with regards to the List of Contracts (Table 1), Seedling Production (Table 2), Plantation Establishment (Table 3) and Maintenance and Protection (M&P Forms) for your information, review, and record.

Hereunder is a brief discussion of our accomplishment based on the five (5) significant performance indicators: area contracted, seedlings produced, area planted, area maintained and protected, and financial performances.

NGP Targets vs Area Contracted

As of August 2022, the region through its implementing PENROs and CENROs had only completed 4462 hectares or 83% of the 5343 hectares target area. Meanwhile, a total of 723 families have been engaged under the MIMAROPA Region, 5 were contracted for FY 2022 Implementation, 713 for second year plantation establishment and 5 for third year plantation establishment.

Please find the attached report on the monthly status of NGP targets and accomplishments in the identified Barangays under NTF-ELCAC as of August 2022.

The NGP projects within identified barangays under NTF-ELCAC have a total area for development of 802.5 hectares located in seven (7) ELCAC barangays namely **Cabacao, Naibuan, Batasan** in Occidental Mindoro, **Milagrosa, San Isidro** in Oriental Mindoro and **Salogon, and Samariniana** in Palawan involving 194 families.

Further, an area of 784.64 hectares with 387,180 seedlings are being maintained under the jurisdiction of PENRO Oriental Mindoro, Occidental Mindoro and PENRO Palawan. On the contrary, the remaining areas unmaintained are identified as the backlogs under the jurisdiction of CENRO San Jose, Occidental Mindoro. Moreover, 2nd year maintenance and protection is still ongoing with a total contract amount of Php 710,047.50 disbursed by PENRO Palawan and PENRO Oriental Mindoro.

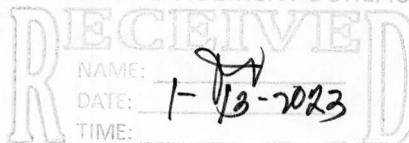

Relative thereto, a total area of 784.64 hectares with 386,800 seedlings are being maintained under the jurisdiction of PENRO Oriental Mindoro, Occidental Mindoro and Palawan. Moreover, 2nd year maintenance and protection activities stipulated on the WFP and MOA under the jurisdiction of PENRO Oriental Mindoro are already completed by the ENGP Partners.

For financial status, a total of Php 869,970.50 of contracted amount was disbursed by PENRO Palawan and PENRO Oriental Mindoro.

Please find the attached consolidated report of National Greening Program under MIMAROPA Region's physical and financial performance on the maintenance and protection of macro-somatic clonal nursery facilities and the production of cloned seedlings as of the month of October 2022, for your information, reference and record.

Relative thereto, a total of 8,872 cuttings of Bitao, Dao, Kalantas, Molave, Philippine teak, Batino, Batikuling, Alamaciga, and Kalingag were processed this month and a total of 1,333 rooted cloned seedlings were processed last July and August this year. The low number of rooted cloned seedlings was due to unrepaired vital cloning facilities, leading to unsuccessful development of root system of the processed cuttings which is very sensitive during rooting period.

However, CENRO Roxas initiated strategies to increase the production of cloned produced by putting coconut palm as temporary shed for the processed cuttings so that it will not to absorb direct sunlight to prevent wilting. The NGP staff continued the clonal propagation in the arboretum located at Brgy. Bukal using non-mist technique. Further, CENRO Roxas Office also maintained one (1) functional clonal nursery.

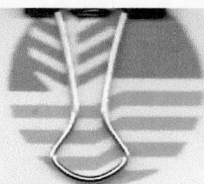
