Respectfully submitting is the report of the undersigned pertains to the above subject.

Please be informed that this office facilitated a meeting with the above mentioned People's Organization headed by CENRO Conrado M. Corpuz together with CDS Chief Forester Clarissa Pador, OIC-Chief, CBFM Unit Zion S. Sunit and the undersigned with the support of Barangay Council led by Punong Brgy. Honorable Lanie G. Abogado regarding their project entitled "Fuel Wood with Orchard Plantation" on December 1, 2022.

During the meeting CDS Chief Pador discussed the current situation of the project that despite of all reminders and advices for a long time, still the project was not completed. Even the commitment made on August 23, 2022 to haul the seedlings and start the planting activity for the remaining 8.75has to accomplish it before the end of October, 2022 was not done thus the project still unfinished. Further, she emphasized that the office is willing to assist on the needs of the PO to accomplish the project. Meanwhile, Chairman Nonita Bibat stated that she already paid the seedling producer with the total amount of P18,000.00 that consisted of 1,200 Langka, 1,200 Guyabano and 3,000 Gmelina, but due to lockdown brought by the covid-19 pandemic in 2020, the scheduled delivery was cancelled and as a result, the seedlings were already over grown. Accordingly, the seedling producer committed to reproduce another seedlings as a replacement or to refund the amount and likewise promised to give an update on December 3, 2022. Mrs. Bibat also said that she has prospect for another source of seedlings in Brgy. Bato and Brgy. Alacalian within the municipality of Taytay and committed again to finish the project. Therefore, the office once again trusted the words of PO Chairman but will be under closely monitoring.

CENRO Corpuz, highlighted the significance of the Community Based Forest Management (CBFM) both to the environment and community with the help of Local Government Unit (LGU). He stated that through CARP project, the PO can generate funds for their member or

beneficiaries to establish the plantation of Forest, Fruit trees, vegetables and other agroforestry products. Moreover, the PO should give value and importance to the project that has been given to them because there are many opportunities for the PO if they can be trusted. Thus, the PO should persist to complete and maintain the project otherwise, the efforts as well as the funds given will be wasted. Punong Barangay Abogado promised to support and extend assistance for the success of the project.

On the other hand, Hon. Abogado raised their request on a portion of land within the CBFM area to be allotted for the public cemetery and Material Recovery Facility (MRF). Currently, their deceased need to bury in other barangay and their waste materials are accommodated by the town MRF thus these appeal are essential. CBFM Unit OIC Chief Sunit, informed them that there's already allocated area for their request with the total area of 1.75has, however, there were illegal claimants in the area. In order to settle the conflict, the said family will be summoned by Hon. Abogado and promised to settle the issue. The area was later visited by the team and CENRO Corpuz advised the barangay chairman to secure the area and put some signage for the awareness of the public.






Photo showing the allocated area for public cemetery and MRF
