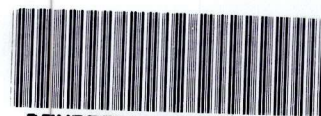

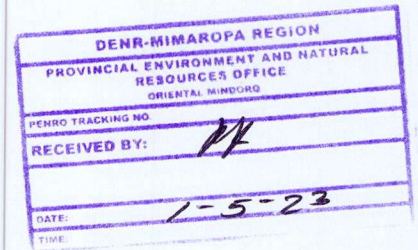

The undersigned monitored and validated the conduct of 4th Regular PAMB Meeting of Naujan Lake National Park (NLNP) in DENR-CENRO Socorro, Barangay Pasi II, Socorro, Oriental Mindoro (see Figure 1). The activity was conducted on November 29, 2022 via hybrid form (face-to-face and virtual).



The resolutions passed include:

- 1) **Resolution No. 10 Series of 2022** – Resolution Allowing the Conduct of Research Study Entitled “Risk Assessment of Potential Invasive Species in Lake Naujan”;
- 2) **Resolution No. 11 Series of 2022** – Resolution Allowing the Conduct of Research Study Entitled “Phylogenetics, Population Genetics and Morphological Analyses of Common Philippine Freshwater Gobioid Fishes”;
- 3) **Resolution No. 12 Series of 2022** – Resolution Allowing the Conduct of Research Study Entitled “Population Genetics and Geometric Morphometric Analysis of Silver Perch, *Leiopotherapon Plumbeus* (Kner, 1864)”;
- 4) **Resolution No. 13 Series of 2022** – Resolution Endorsing the Concept for Establishment of the Naujan Lake Wetland Center in Naujan Lake National Park;
- 5) **Resolution No. 14 Series of 2022** – Resolution Allowing the Conduct of Capstone Project Entitled “NLNP-PAMO Online Permit and Membership Monitoring Database System”;
- 6) **Resolution No. 15 Series of 2022** – Resolution Endorsing the Conduct of Study About the Management of Bonbon Fishing Method in Naujan Lake National Park;
- 7) **Resolution No. 16 Series of 2022** – Resolution Endorsing the Clearance for the Proposed Construction of Five (5)- Kilometer Barangay Road in Barangay Montelago, Naujan Within Naujan Lake National Park;
- 8) **Resolution No. 17 Series of 2022** – Resolution Endorsing the Clearance for the Proposed Construction of Five (5) Hundred- Meter Pathwalk in Barangay Batongdalig, Socorro Within Naujan Lake National Park;
- 9) **Resolution No. 18 Series of 2022** –Resolution Endorsing the Clearance for the Requests for Cutting of Planted Gmelina and Mahogany Trees Within Naujan Lake National Park; and
- 10) **Resolution No. 19, Series of 2022** – Resolution Endorsing the Clearance for the Construction and Operation of Vendo Gasoline Stations Within Naujan Lake National Park.

The PAMB meeting was attended by 45 participants (26 PAMB members/ representatives and 19 guests). Meanwhile, four (4) PAMB members were not able to attend the meeting.



The list of categorical recommendations on PAPs for consideration include:

1. Further strengthen the linkage and partnership with the National Government Agencies (NGAs), Local Government Units (LGUs), Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), private sectors and other stakeholders to efficiently conserve, manage and protect the coastal and marine resources of Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro;
 2. Provision of bigger allotment for representation expenses to further strengthen and to conduct more IEC campaign activities; and
 3. Provision of fund/ conduct Training on Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Campaign and/ or Public Speaking to the IEC Campaign Officers, IEC Campaign members and other personnel to capacitate and further enhance their skills in public speaking and IEC campaign activities.

The undersigned monitored the production and distribution of IEC campaign materials on ecological solid waste management to the Municipal and Barangay Local Government Units (LGUs) of Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro (see Figure 3). The distribution was held on December 13, 2022 in simultaneous to the IEC campaign on Easement Regulation, Republic Act No. 9003 (The Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000) and Republic Act No. 7942 (The Philippine Mining Act of 1995).

A total of 410 IEC campaign materials on ecological solid waste management were distributed to the LGUs (Municipal and Barangays) and schools (Puerto Galera National High School Main and Dulangan Extension) that participated in the IEC campaign.

The list of categorical recommendations on PAPs for consideration include:

1. Further strengthen the linkage and partnership with the National Government Agencies (NGAs), Local Government Units (LGUs), Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), private sectors and other stakeholders in ecological solid waste management; and
2. Provision of bigger allotment for the production and distribution of IEC campaign materials.

The undersigned coordinated with the Barangays of Aninuan, Balatero, Dulangan and Tabinay, Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro on December 13, 2022 regarding the monitoring of marine turtle nesting sites (see Figure 4). The nesting sites in the Barangays of Aninuan, Balatero, Dulangan and Tabinay, Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro are among the marine turtle nesting sites listed by the MENRO through their communication letter dated March 28, 2022, with Barangay Aninuan having the latest emergence of hatchlings happened on November 29, 2021.

No new marine turtle activities (nesting and emergence), encounter (stranding, injured, death) and/ or poaching incidence were relayed to them as per the coordination and interview with the Barangay Councilor Lenito S. Pampilo of Barangay Aninuan, Barangay Chairperson Ramil V. Candava of Barangay Balatero, Barangay Councilor Benito L. De Leon of Barangay Dulangan and the new Barangay Chairperson Bayani Materiales of Barangay Tabinay.

To further strengthen the linkage and partnership with the said LGUs, the undersigned rendered communication letters requesting to coordinate and/ or report any activities/ incidence on marine turtles. This will serve as basis for the formulation and/ or implementation of various PAPs with regards to the conservation, management and protection of marine turtles in the province. The contact number and email address were provided in the communication letters dated December 13, 2022 to serve as their information and reference.




Furthermore, about eight (8) IEC campaign materials on marine turtles, sea grass, mangrove forest and Marine Protected Area (MPA) were given to the Barangays of Aninuan, Balatero, Dulangan and Tabinay, Puerto Galera to effectively manage their coastal and marine resources.

The list of categorical recommendations on PAPs for consideration include:

1. Further strengthen the linkage and partnership with the National Government Agencies (NGAs), Local Government Units (LGUs), Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), private sectors and other stakeholders to efficiently conserve, manage and protect the marine turtle nesting sites of Puerto Galera, Oriental Mindoro;
2. Provision of fund/ construction of marine turtle hatchery in marine turtle nesting sites; and
3. Provision of bigger allotment for the production and distribution of IEC campaign materials
