Respectfully forwarded herewith are copies of reports/updates in summary of Lawin Patrolling conducted within the area of jurisdiction of CENRO Brooke's Point, Palawan from November 16 to December 19, 2022.

Based on the said summary, a total of 65.450 kilometers of foot and seaborne patrolling activities within the forestland area/conservation area was accomplished, equivalent to 130.90% of the 50 kilometers monthly target of this Office computed based on the 600 kilometers annual target indicated in the approved Work and Financial Plan for CY 2022. However, this figure includes patrol data with GPS error/s reported to the Lawin Help Desk for assessment and updating of FMB Lawin Unit. Thus, the total accomplished patrol distance may still be further reduce/decrease.

Further, Patrol observation records show that the forest conditions in the areas patrolled are mainly characterized by advanced secondary forests. Likewise, for this period, no environmental threat/s has been documented.

As described in the table above, the forest condition in conservation areas covered by LAWIN Patrols of CENRO Brooke's Point for the month of December 2022 is dominated by **Advanced Secondary Forests.** Meanwhile, relatively high observations of moderate regeneration is also recorded which may indicate forest cover recovery.


