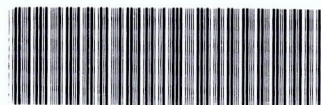
SUBJECT : **REPORT ON THE FLOODINGS INCIDENTS WITHIN THE
PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

Furnished is the Terminal Report provided by the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (PDRRMO) of Oriental Mindoro relative to the flooding incidents within the Province as of January 9, 2023.

Please be informed that based on the report, a total of 15,654 families were affected by the flooding incident, of which, 1,471 individuals were evacuated. Likewise, four (4) houses were damaged/washed out and class were suspended in the Municipality of Baco and Naujan on January 4 and January 5, 2023, respectively. A total of Php 58,428,963.88 agricultural losses within the Province of Oriental Mindoro.

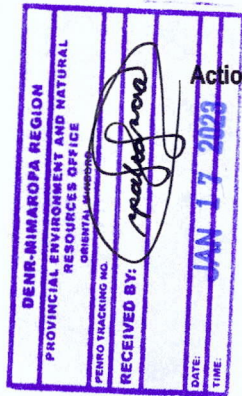
TERMINAL REPORT

"BLUE ALERT STATUS" due to the effects of Northeast Monsoon and LPA in South Southwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan and East Northeast of Surigao City, Surigao Del Norte

Date/Period: January 4 – 9, 2023

Actions Taken:

- Activated the Provincial Emergency Operations Center - "BLUE ALERT STATUS" due to the effects of Northeast Monsoon and LPA in South Southwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan and East Northeast of Surigao City, Surigao Del Norte
- Monitored rivers, roads and highways in Calapan City and Baco;
- Coordinated with MDRRMO Baco re: flooded areas and status of roads
- Distributed of food packs to the affected families at Baco and Naujan
- Twelve (12) PDRRMO personnel on duty at the Provincial DRRM Office/Provincial EOC;
- Province wide monitoring of weather condition, power interruptions and untoward incidents thru call and text and multimedia from MDRRMOs;
- Documentated and submitted reports.

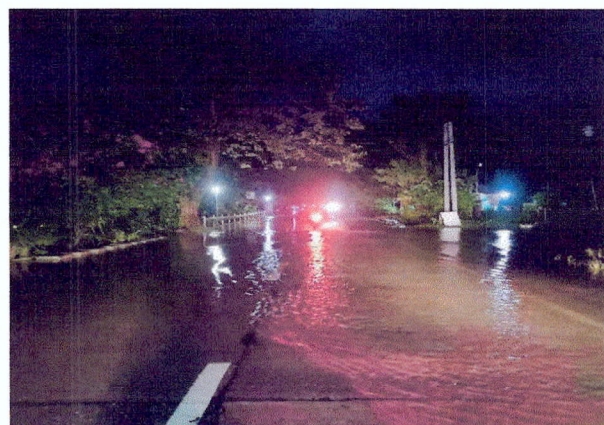
