

Please be informed that there were a total of sixteen (16) apprehensions in the entire region with most of the reports came from the province of Palawan. The said apprehensions amounted to a total of **P158,488.70** for the estimated fair market value of the forest products excluding the market value of the apprehended two (2) units of chainsaw and nine (9) units of conveyances.

For the cases filed, there were three (3) cases pending at the Provincial Prosecutors Office of the Province of Oriental and Occidental Mindoro.







Respectfully submitted are the Memoranda dated 30 September 2022 and 28 November 2022 of PENRO Romblon regarding the above-mentioned subject. This is the completion report in compliance to target activity under OO1: Natural Resources Conservation Program: Protected Areas, Caves, and Wetlands Development and Management Sub-Program: Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) based on PA Management Plan of CALSANAG Watershed Forest Reserve (CWFR) and Mt. Guiting-Guiting Natural Park (MGGNP) in Romblon.

The sample/initial draft of photo checklist booklets were reviewed based on the DENR guidelines such as DENR Administrative Order No. 2017-11 "Updated National List of Threatened Philippine Plants and their Categories", DENR Administrative Order No. 2019-09 "Updated National List of Threatened Philippine Fauna and their Categories", and the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) Red List.

Further, we instructed the PENRO to consider the following comments and recommendations to improve the photo checklist booklets:

- 1. Improve the layout by including introduction page, acknowledgement page and definition of terms;
- 2. Use originally-taken and high-resolution photographs. If photographs were gathered from secondary sources, do not compress or elongate/stretch the image of the flora and fauna and include proper citation of species listed;
- 3. Consistency in proper writing of scientific names (i.e. always italicized) as well as consistency in the use of font size of the species listed must be observed;
- 4. Review the typographical errors such as spelling/misprint of scientific names;
- 5. Double check the latest and correct scientific name of the species:
- 6. Specify the source of conservation status of the species and the species description;
