In order to address one of the gender issues: Limited Participation of Women in Sustainable Management of the Environment and Natural Resources (ENR), the CENRO Puerto Princesa has a target to conduct capacity building on ENR management involving women within barangays covering watershed areas.

The said target has an allotment of Php 10,000.00 from the GAD imposition fund which the office used for the travelling expenses of the GADFPS members and purchasing of thirty (30) pieces reusable tumblers. With the limited funds available to conduct such activity, this office requested partnership and support from USAID Safe Water through our letter dated September 14, 2022 addressed to Engr. Ryan Fuentes, Field Technical Manager of USAID Safe Water Project Palawan.

On September 19, 2022, the USAID Safe Water replied to our request informing the office that they had activities designed for women in communities of Aborlan and Puerto Princesa City and they are looking forward to collaborate with our office in strengthening the role of women in ENR and watershed management.

For the month of October 2022, the USAID Safe Water organized the following capacity buildings/trainings at Aborlan, Palawan with CENRO Puerto Princesa GADFPS as the resource persons on Environment and Natural Resources (ENR):

- 3. Capacity Building/Training on Establishment of Community Managed Savings and Credit Association (CoMSCA), October 4 to 5, 2022
- 4. Capacity Building/Training on Soil Collection and Sampling, Organic Vegetable Farming, and Demo Farm Establishment, October 18, 2022

The purpose of USAID Safe Water trainings is to enable the people's organizations (POs) or communities on savings movement and popularize CoMSCA as tool towards financial resilience; to adopt sustainable practices in farming and enhanced knowledge of communities on basic organic vegetable farming and integrated farming system.

During the Capacity Building on Establishment of Community Managed Savings and Credit Association (CoMSCA) held on October 4 to 5, 2022 at Tagcodec, Barangay San Juan, Aborlan, Palawan, ECOMS I Arlene B. Basaya, GADFPS member discussed DENR information and National Greening Program (NGP) while the undersigned, conducted lectures on Environmental Laws; Importance of Watershed; and Role of Women in Watershed Management. Likewise, lecture on Gender and Development (GAD) was also presented to the participants to enhance their awareness.

The twenty-seven (27) participants of the said training are members of Ma'res Nga Mga Babay Kat Barangay Sagpangan, an all Women IP Group in Barangay Sagpangan, Aborlan, Palawan. The participants were also provided with reusable water tumblers to promote "no to single use plastic" and the use of eco-friendly materials in order to help save and conserve the environment and our planet earth.

On October 18, 2022, this office was again invited by USAID Safe Water to provide lectures on ENR and watershed management during the Training on Organic Vegetable Farming and Demo Farm Establishment held at DosFourDos Farm, Magsaysay, Aborlan, Palawan. The undersigned, discussed Environmental Laws, Importance of Watershed; and the Role of Women in Watershed Management. A brief lecture on Gender and Development (GAD) was also provided.

A total of forty-eight (48) participants attended the said event consisted of twenty (20) males and twenty-eight (28) females coming from different barangays in Aborlan, Palawan. Some of the participants are Indigenous Peoples living within and adjacent the watershed area. Vitamins and Tayo ang Kalikasan Bamboo Ballpens were distributed to the participants.
