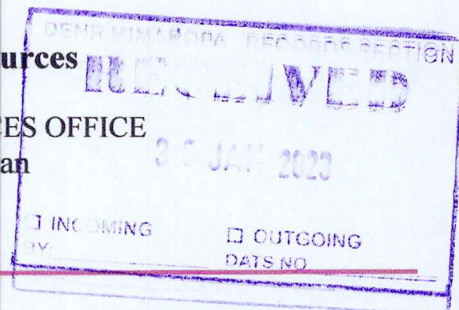

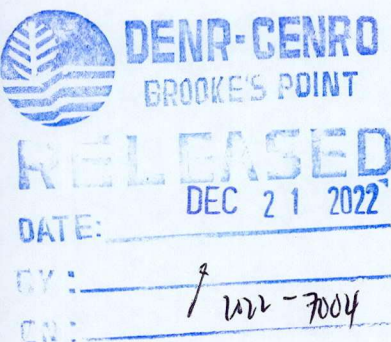

**SUBJECT : CREATION OF CENRO TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR THE REVERSION OF THE ABANDONED, UNDERDEVELOPED AND UNDERUTILIZED FISHPONDS WITHIN AOJ OF CENRO BROOKE'S POINT, PALAWAN**

In the interest of the service and in line with DENR Special Order No. 2021-274 entitled, "Creation of DENR Technical Working Group for the Reversion of the Abandoned, Underdeveloped and Underutilized (AUU) Fishponds and other Related Mangrove Conservation and Rehabilitation Policies and in adherence to the agreement reached during the Orientation and Levelling-Off Workshop on AUU Fishponds held on October 17-21, 2022 allowing the Regional Offices to undertake certain activities while awaiting for the approval/issuance of DENR Administrative Order on the Reversion and Management of AUUFs, a CENRO Technical Working Group is hereby created to be composed of the following personnel to wit:

They shall hold initial discussions with counterparts in the DA-BFAR, DILG and DAR, and LGUs concerned on AUU Fishponds within the administrative jurisdiction of this Office.

They shall intensify coordination efforts with concern agencies on fishponds with FLAs and NGP areas.


They shall validate the location and status of AUU Fishponds particularly DA-BFAR-reported reverted Fishpond Lease Agreements (FLAs) in coordination with counterparts in DA-BFAR.



They shall collect drone shots and conduct mapping of FLAs based on mangrove zonification data and/or available reference maps from FMB and NAMRIA.

They shall submit the corresponding information and report with categorical recommendations (*such as recommend priority AUUFs for reversion to forestland*) for submission and consolidation of the PENRO and/or Regional Office.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain enforce until revoked in writing by the undersigned and/or higher authorities.
