

**DENR CBFM-CARP AGROFORESTRY PLANTATION IN COMBINATION OF FRUIT TREES

ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT OF BANTOTO ABAROAN FARMERS ASSOCIATION INC.

I. Introductions

Mahogany and Gmelina for timber production alongside Ipil-Ipil for charcoal production intercropped with agri-crops such as pineapple, papaya, and cassava for immediate food production with fruit trees kalamansi, langka, rambutan, Suha and Stingless bee for Lagundi-honey production was implemented by the People's Organization (PO) Bantoto Abaroan Farmers Association Inc. (BAFAI). This PO was formerly named Bantoto Abaroan Farmers Marketing Cooperative (BAFARMCO) with CBFMA NO: 2000-11, the association managed to register with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) bearing Reg. No. 010-530 on September 14, 2017.

Further, as of to date, the PO had completed the repair of a nursery using bamboo, net, and slabs, located near their Rattan Bodega at Purok Maagap. In that Nursery where located raised all seedlings based on the approved Work and Financial Plan (WFP), they have completed forest trees and fruit trees, and already procured fertilizers. Meanwhile, they have already planted a total area of 40 hectares, including seedlings of 18,000 Mahogany, 500 Ipil-Ipil, 1500 Kalamansi, 1,171 langka, and 1,000 rambutan. For ease of supervision, the PO created a team, headed by their Project Manager from seedlings production to out planting. Furthermore, to prevent conflict and misunderstanding, the PO Chairperson conducted meetings with the officers prior to the withdrawal of funds to discuss the payment of items and other expenses.

This Office is constantly supervising and technically coaching the PO in performing their activities per the approved Work and Financial Plan of a Schedule of Billing. Progress reports with geo-tag photos are being submitted monthly including this annual summary report to the PENRO and Regional Office.



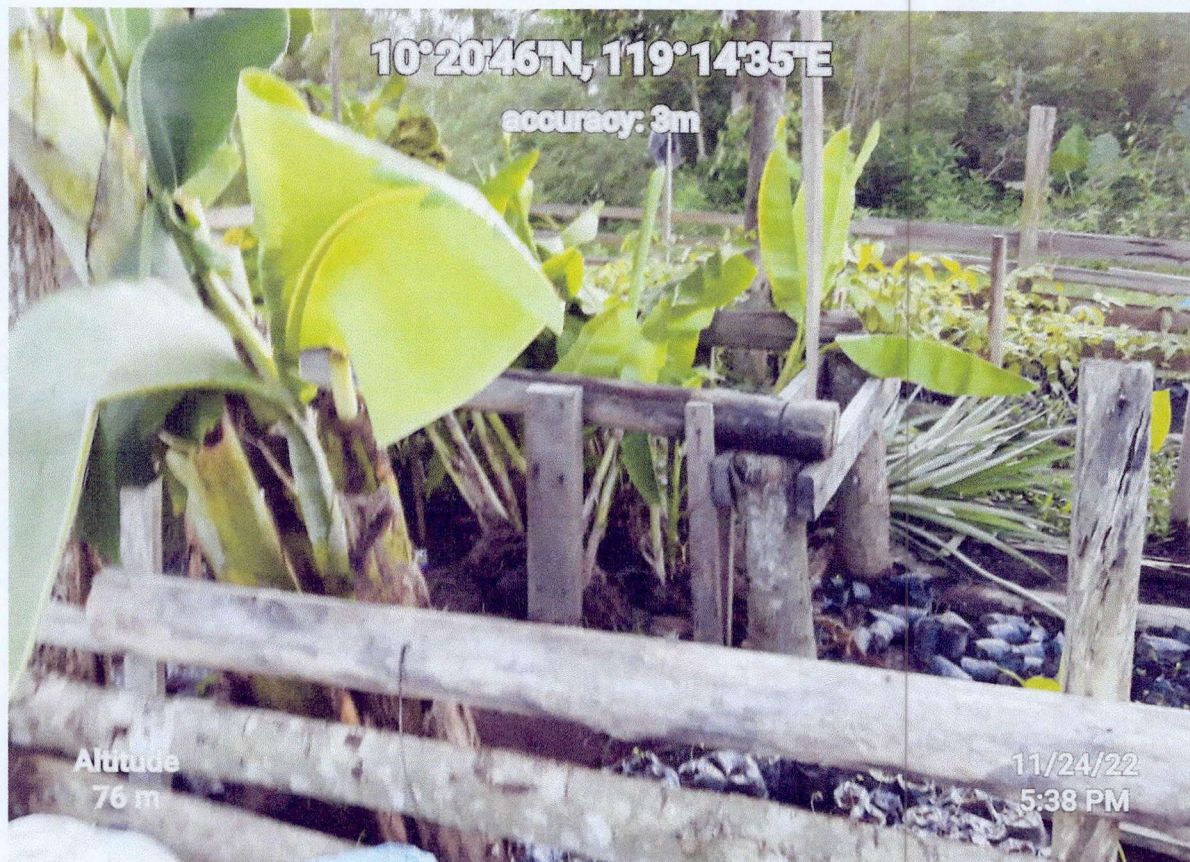


Figure2. The Geo-tagged photographs above show the BAFAI nursery establishment during the monitoring of Nursery operation located at So. Bantoto, Brgy. Abaroan, Roxas, Palawan

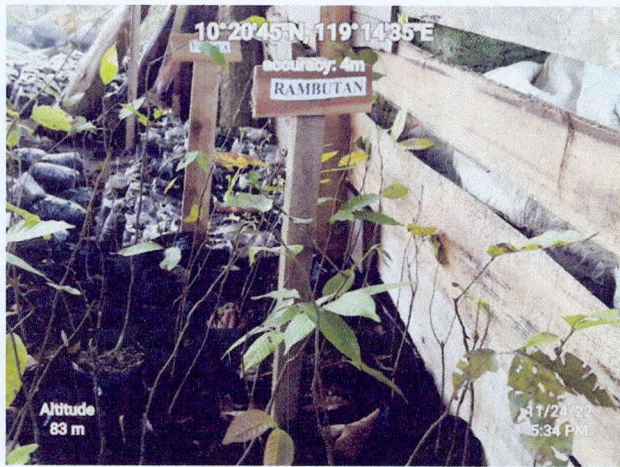


Figure 6. The Geo-tagged photographs above show the BAFAI fruit trees produced such as Langka, Suha, Kalamansi and Rambutan was planted in their CARP Agroforestry project located at So. Bantoto, Brgy. Abaroan, Roxas, Palawan.



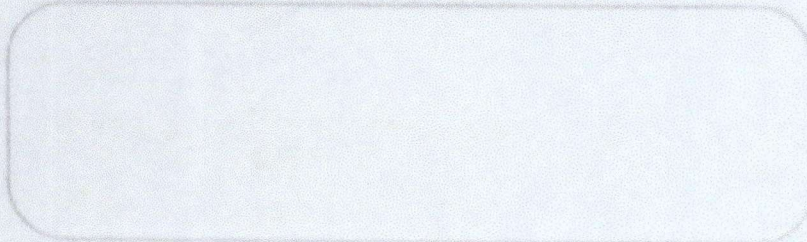
Figure 7. The Geo-tagged photographs above showing the conducted Socio Economic Environmental Baseling (SEEB) of BAFAI located at So. Bantoto, Brgy. Abaroan, Roxas, Palawan.

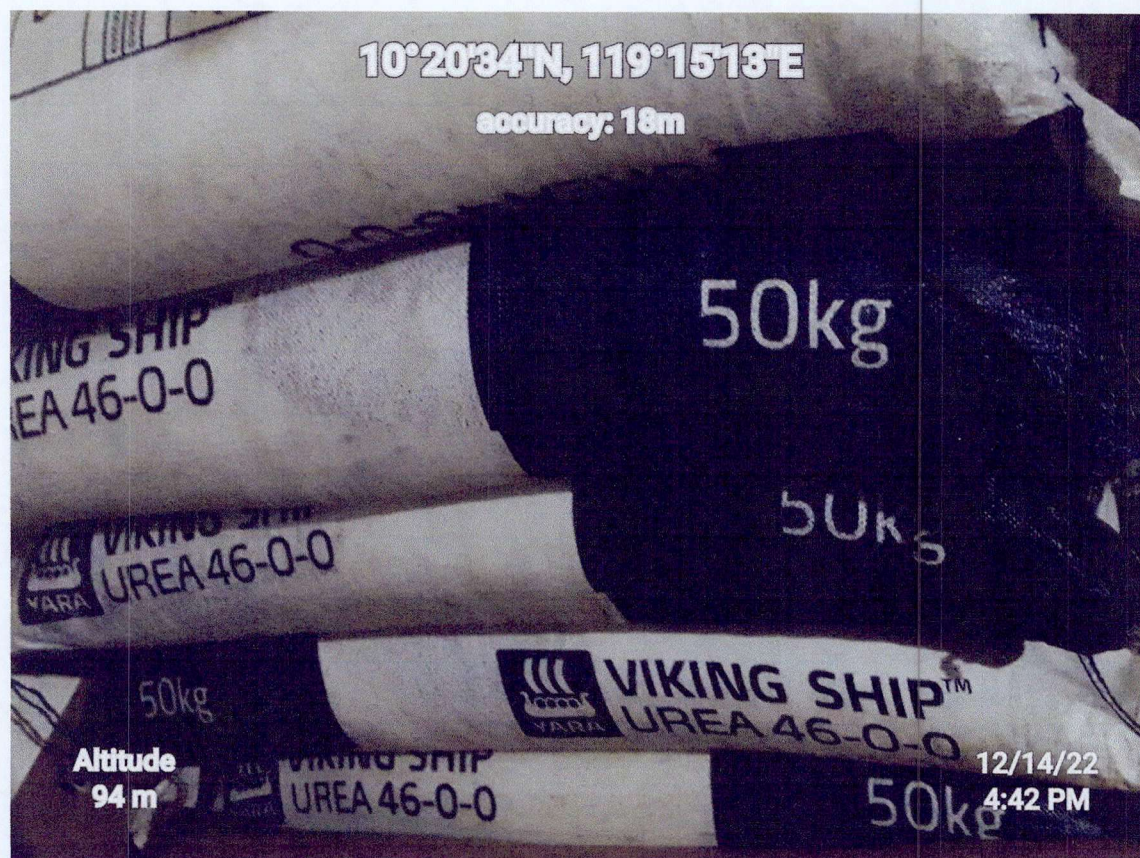

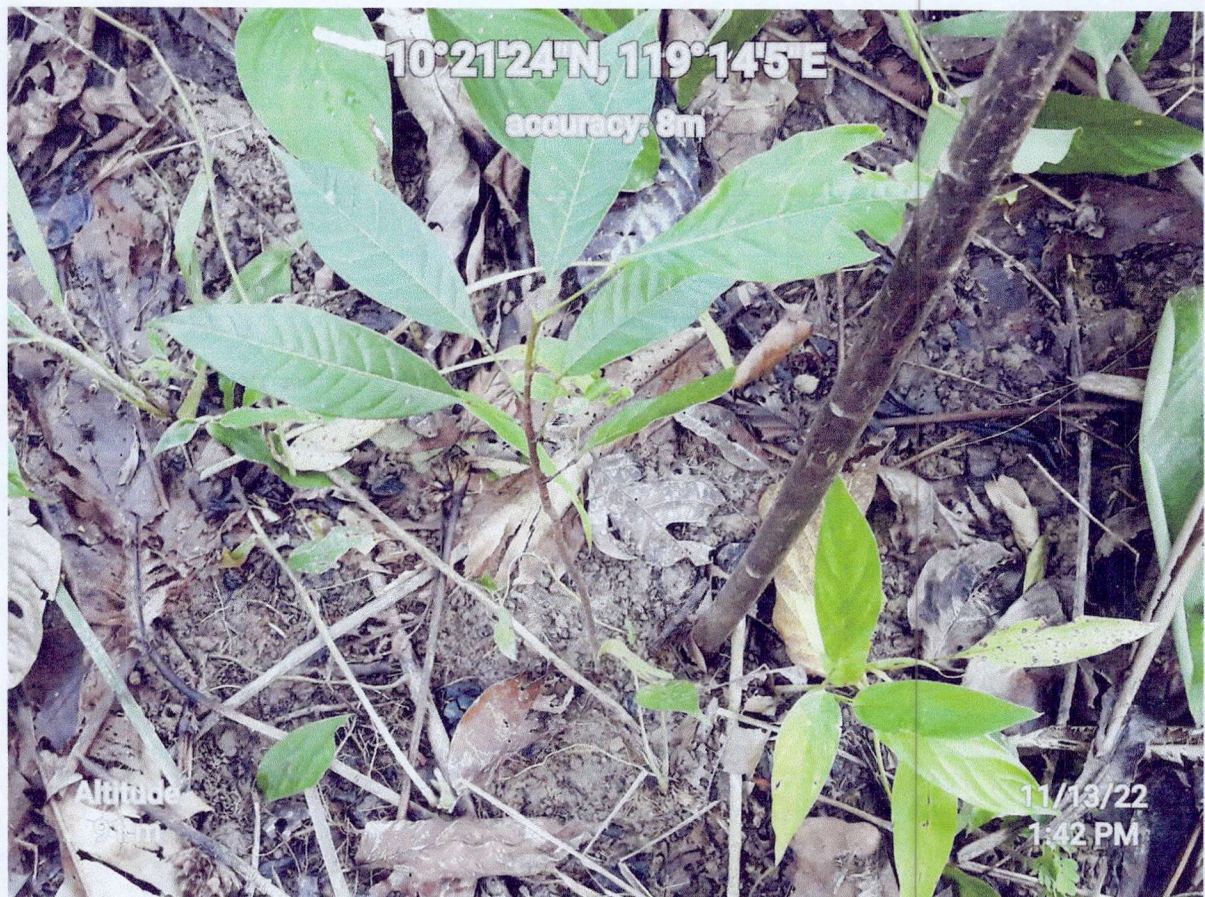
Figures 8. The Geo-tagged photographs above showing the passbook of accounts: Land bank of the Philippines, Puerto Princesa City of BAFAL.



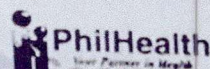

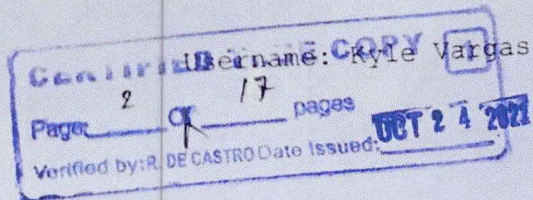
