Please be informed that on November 23, 2022, this Office conducted the abovementioned subject to monitor an alleged mangrove cutting used for charcoal making within Yabang River of Sitio Yakal, Barangay New Guinlo and alleged operation of palapad in the river of mangrove area of Sitio Pinagupitan, Barangay Abongan, however no illegal activities observed and recorded.

Likewise, on the next day, the team continuously conducted the mentioned activity to monitor illegal fishing activities within the vicinities of Sitio Kawakayan, Balimbing and Pinagpala, Barangay Alacalian and no illegal activities monitored and recorded.

Hence, this Office recommends to intensify the patrol and monitoring within marine areas of MSPLS and continuously coordinated with the BLGUs and other partners to hinder illegal activities.

This pertains on the conducted seaborne patrol and monitoring in the above mentioned date and place.

Please be informed that on November 23, 2022, we the undersigned conducted seaborne patrol and mangrove monitoring in the vicinity of Barangay New Guinlo and Abongan, Taytay, Palawan. The team checked and monitored alleged mangrove cutting used in charcoal making in the mangrove area of Yabang river at Sitio Yakal, Barangay New Guinlo and alleged operation of palapad net in the river entrance in the mangrove area of Sitio Pinagupitan, Barangay Abongan, Taytay, Palawan. During the conducted patrolling there is no illegal activity observed in the area.

Please be informed also that in the night of November 24, 2022 at around 9:20 in the evening the team departed at Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) at Barangay Old Guinlo, Taytay, Palawan to monitored illegal fishing activity in the vicinity of Sitio Kawakayan, Balimbing, Pinagpala, Barangay Alacalian and in the vicinity of Sitio Malaya and Binataan, Barangay Banbanan, Taytay, Palawan, During the conducted night seaborne patrol and monitoring on the said area there is no illegal activity observed all night until daylight. During that night until daylight the team encountered bad weather, so the team decided to stopped the patrolling at around 7:30 in the morning of November 25, 2022 and back to Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) at Barangay Old Guinlo, Taytay, Palawan.
