MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding made and entered into by and between among:

The REGIONAL EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES, MIMAROPA Region, with principal address at 1515 DENR by the Bay Bldg. Roxas Blvd, Bgy. 668, Ermita, Manila, represented by Regional Executive Director LORMELYN E. CLAUDIO, CESO IV, herein referred to as the DENR,

-and-

CORON SCHOOL OF FISHERIES, a public school located in Barangay Poblacion I, Coron, Palawan, represented by Director DR. BENJAMIN E. ABLAZA, hereinafter referred to as CSF;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Green Economy Model (GEM) project of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources – CENRO Coron will be implemented in order to accelerate the rehabilitation of the degraded ecosystems and Coron is one of the GEM sites in Palawan.

WHEREAS, the GEM will transform DENR programs and projects into GEMs where household members create sustainable good and services for the rehabilitation of degraded ecosystems and promote the protection of the environment through the creation of green jobs.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Republic Act No. 10771 dated April 29, 2016 or the Philippines Green Jobs Act of 2016, which intends to promote the creation of green jobs, funds and incentives; in the view of the Philippines Development Plan (PDP) 2017-2022. This approach is inclusive development and is anchored on the AmBisyon Natin 2040: Matatag, Maginhawa, at Panatag na Buhay.

WHEREAS, the DENR is committed to create active collaboration with Palawan State University to generate green jobs and improve human well-being and social equity in reducing environmental risk and ecological scarcities.

WHEREAS, the PSU recognizes the importance of establishing partnership with the DENR to increase the capacity in promoting, conserving and accelerate the rehabilitation of degraded ecosystem in Coron, Palawan.

WHEREAS, in the interest of public service the PSU is dedicated to improve partnership and empower the youth and stakeholders to minimize flooding and siltation by application of strict implementation of ENR Laws and practice proper waste disposal.

A. SCOPE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF PALAWAN STATE UNIVERSITY

 Provide or identify young active students and faculty who are qualified to join the activities of the DENR-GEM project.



- Participate in conducting strategic communication, information and education campaign of ENR Laws and policies such as PD 705 or Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines, RA 9003 or Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 as well as the advocacies of DENR in protection and conservation of our natural resources;
- 3. Support the initiatives of DENR in helping GEM project by providing relevant information, photos and in the coordination with personalities who may be featured in the documentation.
- 4. Participates in the community mobilization, preparation and organization for purposes of DENR activities and advocacies.
- 5. Allow the use of campus facilities for workshop, meetings and other project activities and provide logistical support such as sound system, tables, chairs, and other appropriate and necessary equipment.

B. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DENR

- 1. Provide mentoring and training throughout the duration of the project if needed;
- 2. Provides training, seminars and Information, Education and Communication (IEC) campaign and other related to the project.
- Collaborate with PSU internship program by accommodating student interns in DENR-CENRO Coron office;
- 4. Work closely with the office assigned staff and leaders to ensure the participation in the various environmental efforts.
- 5. Assist the PSU in the documentation of the project by providing relevant information, photos and in the coordination with personalities who may be featured in the documentation.

C. AMENDMENTS

All parties mutually agree upon any amendment to this agreement.

D. EFFECTIVITY

This Agreement shall take effect for two years from October 2022 – December 2024 upon signing by the representatives of both parties and shall remain in full force until terminated by mutual agreement.
