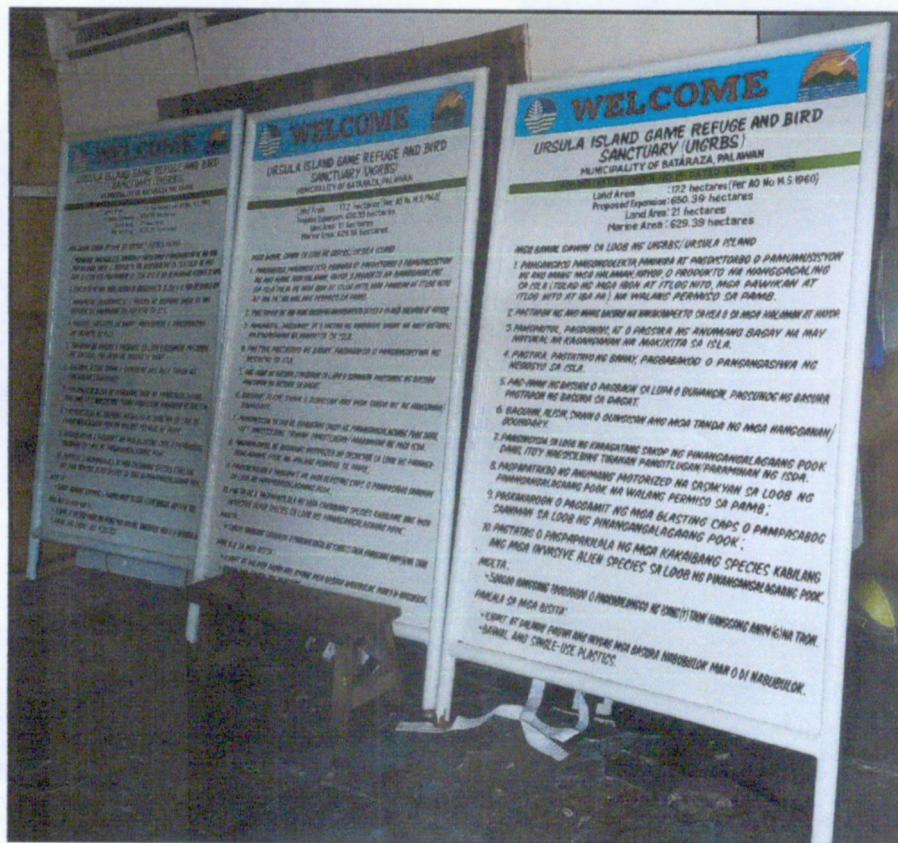


## Distribution of Pamphlets and Wildlife Signage

**Common Name:** Alagau

**Scientific Name:** *Premna odorata*

**Family Name:** Lamiaceae



**Local Name** (include also other areas):

Adgaw, Alagao, Abgao, Argao, Agdao, Anobran

**DISTRIBUTION:** Australia, Bismarck Arch, Borneo, Cambodia, China, India, Indian Ocean, Java, Laos, Lesser Sunda Isls, Malay Peninsula, Moluccas, Myanmar, New Guinea, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Sulawesi, Sumatra, Taiwan, Vietnam. Throughout the archipelago in most islands and provinces. Common in lowland thickets and secondary forests. (CO's Digital Flora of the Philippines)

**CHARACTERISTICS:** Indigenous, Ever-green to semi-deciduous, a shrubby to small tree reaching a height of 4-8 meters; Trunks are woody or herbaceous up to 35cm; Leaves are simple, opposite, ovate, hairy underneath, leaves are aromatic when crushed; Flowers in panicles, very small, greenish white, monoecious; Fruits are small drupe, round, green to deep purple or black, 3-5mm., fruiting from April to June.

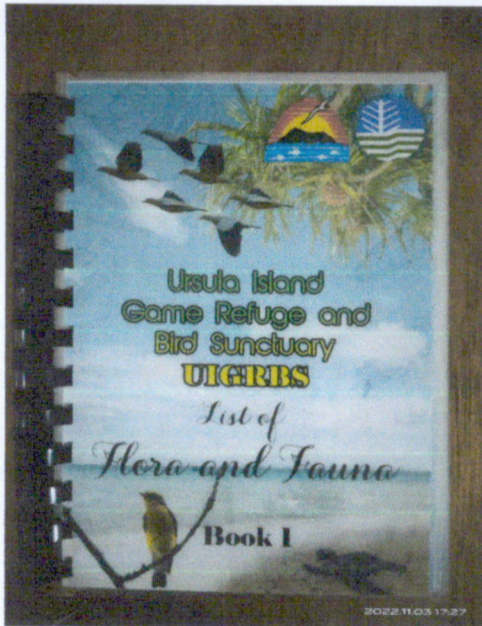
**CONSERVATION STATUS:** Not Threatened Least Concern (The IUCN Red List of Threatened Species in 2020)

**USES:** Nurse Tree for newly planted, slow-growing saplings, wood used as firewood, new leaves used in flavoring local dishes like Pinaksiw, leaves steeped in hot water treat cough, stomach pains and reduce fever.
