In relation to the Green Economy Model's implementation, the GEM team conducted Focused Group Discussion (FGD) in the community of Sitio Balisungan, Barangay Tagumpay, Coron, Palawan on November 3, 2022.

The focus group discussion (FGD) is a quick assessment and qualitative approach to gaining an in-depth understanding of a community perception including issues and concerns related to their source of income or livelihood. This is to collect data from a selected group of participants and conduct a free talk to encourage discussions. This is a collaborative activity with Barangays, local communities of selected barangays of Coron, Palawan.

Thirty-eight (38) individual took part in the aforementioned activity in which identified the lists of livelihood of the communities source of income and potential based on the resources available in the area. Piggery, poultry, gardening, seaweed farming, mud crab raising, mangrove nursery, gleaning, fishing, and ecotourism (bird, firefly, dugong and plankton watching) as well as weaving of baskets and other souvenir materials.

Furthermore, the identified subjects experience multiple challenges based on their perspectives, such as natural phenomena, land ownership conflicts, a lack of resources, overharvesting, markets, knowledge, technology, and funds.

Gathered information were sum-up and briefly discussed. Likewise, all related questions were addressed. Hence, will be consolidate and presented to the top management.

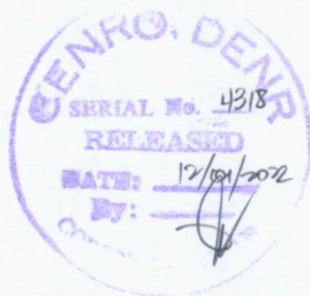

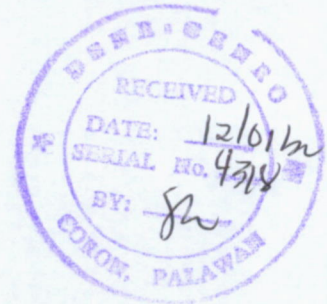

On November 29, 2022, the GEM team held a Focused Group Discussion (FGD) in the community of Barangay Poblacion I, Coron, Palawan, relating to the Green Economy Model (GEM) project implementation.

The focus group discussion (FGD) is a quick assessment and qualitative approach to gaining an in-depth understanding of a community's perception including issues and concerns related to their source of income or livelihood. This is to collect data from a selected group of participants and conduct a free talk to encourage discussions. This collaborative activity was actively participated by twenty-four (24) individuals, 12 male and 12 females, from Barangay officials and local communities.

The process is the same as for other barangays, participants were asked to give an idea of their resources, livelihoods and challenges. During the FGD, participants recognized marine and agricultural resources are available in their area. Selling and producing seafood (making *lamayo*, anchovies, etc.), gardening and crafting souvenirs were also identified as livelihood opportunities as the barangay is centrally located in the town. However, they struggle to take initiative as they lack of area, education/knowledge and also lack of financial means to start their livelihoods and assets which affect their livelihood opportunities.

At this point the information was collected, summarized and briefly discussed. All pertinent questions have been answered. It is then compiled and delivered to top management.

On November 8, 2022, the GEM team held a Focused Group Discussion (FGD) in the community of Barangay Poblacion V, Coron, Palawan, relating to the Green Economy Model (GEM) project implementation.

The focus group discussion (FGD) is a quick assessment and qualitative approach to gaining an in-depth understanding of a community's perception including issues and concerns related to their source of income or livelihood. This is to collect data from a selected group of participants and conduct a free talk to encourage discussions. This collaborative activity was actively participated by sixty-five (65) individual, 14 men and 51 women, from Barangay officials and local communities.

Barangay V shares a common border with the following barangay(s): Barangay Poblacion IV and VI. The main source of living in this barangay is fishing and tourism.

During the FGD the participants recognized livelihood according to their resources; Fish and tourist attractions. The establishment of fish processing and manufacture of fishing gear and the like, then "kayak" or boat rental establishments and goods for tourism purposes were congregated as a livelihood needed in the area. They also mentioned that the alternative revenue source is collecting and selling plastic bottles.

Whereas, they also identified various challenges based on their perspectives, such as lack of resources, storage/facility, knowledge, reclamation, and degraded ecosystem, as well as deficiency of assets that affects their livelihood opportunities.

At this point, information was gathered, summarized, and briefly discussed. All pertinent queries were addressed. Consequently, it will be compiled and delivered to the top management.

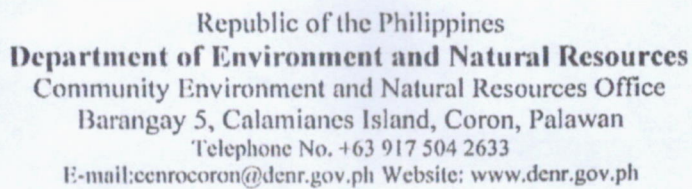

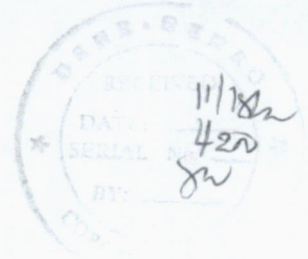

In connection to the DAO 2017-08, states that the DENR aims to transform programs and projects into GEMs where household members create sustainable goods and services for the rehabilitation of degraded ecosystems, create viable community enterprises where households are the focal members and players in creating value-added environmental products and services, and accelerate the rehabilitation of degraded ecosystems and promote the protection of the environment through the creation of green jobs.

Hence, one of the targets to be implemented under Green Economy Model (GEM) is the Focus Group Discussion (FGD) that aims to improve the livelihood and enterprise development of the community. Whereas, the locals in the community will be able to raise their concerns regarding on how they will continue or create a sustainable livelihood that is suitable within their area and continuous conservation of our natural resources.

Said activity was conducted on November 09, 2022 in Barangay Poblacion 6, Coron, Palawan where it was participated by 35 individuals composed of Senior Citizen, Barangay Officials and volunteers from different sectors of the community. Some of the suggestions raised during the FGD was mainly on the rehabilitation of nursery in their coastal areas, handicraft making, souvenir shops, agri-tourism and development of ecotourism such as hiking and mountaineering in Mt. Dalara. During the activity, Barangay Captain Maria V. Cinco mentioned that in Poblacion 6 has a lot of resources especially in their upland areas. Also, there are two (2) watershed areas within their area of jurisdiction that supplies the water in six (6) Poblacion Barangays. Thus, the BLGU discourage such activities that may compromise and risk the vital resources.

All information gathered were sum-up and briefly discussed for a possible recommendation and creation of livelihood opportunities
