In the verification of the compliance of Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) – Occidental Mindoro on the preparation and submission of Gender and Development (GAD) related reports for the Calendar Year (CY) 2022, the following observation was noted:

The approved Gender and Development (GAD) Plan and Budget (GPB), as well as the Accomplishment Report (AR) for CY 2022 were not submitted to the Audit Team within the period prescribed under Item V of COA Circular No.2014-001 dated March 18, 2014.

Item V of COA Circular No. 2014-001 dated March 18, 2014 or the "Revised uidelines in the audit of Gender and Development (GAD) Funds and Activities in overnment agencies" provides the Responsibility of the Audited Agency, as follows:

The Audited agency shall submit a copy of the Annual GAD Plan and Budget (GPB) to the COA Audit Team assigned to the agency within five (5) working days from the receipt of the approved plan from the PCW or their mother or central offices as the case maybe. Likewise, a copy of the corresponding Accomplishment Report shall be furnished the said Audit Team within five (5) working days from the end of January of the preceding year.

Further, Item IV.B.8 states that, In the absence of a GAD Plan and Budget, information shall be secured from the GAD Focal Point or the Chief Accountant of the agency on the sources of funds for GAD. Whether or not the funds used for a specific project were integrated in the regular budget of the agency should also be ascertained.

As of this writing, the agency has already submitted their GAD Plan and Budget as well as the Accomplishment Report. However, the submission was made beyond the period prescribed in the said COA Circular.

Inquiry with the GAD Focal Person disclosed that they were able to submit their GPB to their mother unit, however, they did not receive the approved GPB, hence, causing the delay in the submission of the same to the Audit Team.

Failure of the Management to submit GPB and GAD AR to the COA Audit Team within the prescribed period prevented the timely review and evaluation of the target and implemented GAD projects/program/activities.

We recommend the OIC-PENR Officer to instruct the GAD Focal Point Person to prepare and submit the same Annual GAD Plan and Budget, as well as the Accomplishment reports to the Audit Team within the prescribed period, in accordance with Item V of COA Circular No. 2014-001 dated March 18, 2014 to facilitate the timely review and evaluation of the target and projects/program/activities of the Agency.

We would appreciate receiving your comments on the foregoing audit observations within two (2) calendar days from receipt hereof.
