I. INTRODUCTION

The Community-Based Forest Management (CBFM) is the national strategy for the sustainable development of the country's forest resources and social justice Pursuant to Executive Order No. 236 and Department Administrative Order (DAO) 96-29.

The Community Based Forest Management (CBFM) is the national strategy for the sustainable development of the country's forest resources. This program aims to promote the socio- economic upliftment of forest communities and achieving sustainable development and management of forest resources.

It recognizes the responsible and efficient utilization by organized and empowered local communities based on sound ecological and economic principles can result to sustainable management of forestlands and resources.

The periodic monitoring aims to know the status of the DENR-CARP Projects and other related CBFM activities within their respective areas in compliance with the existing rules and regulations, progress in terms of area development, organizational development and project implementation.

Part of the technical assistance provided to the CBFM partners during the periodic monitoring and assessment is the conduct of a small group of meeting with some BODs members of the association purposely to determine the extent of development undertaken within their respective CBFM areas. The result of the information provided during the meeting including the onsite monitoring and assessment will be the basis in providing them effective recommendations towards sustainable development management of their CBFM areas.

II. LEGAL BASIS

1. Under Executive Order No. 263, the Community Based Forest Management is a national Strategy to ensure sustainable development of the Country's Forestland Resources and providing mechanism for its implementation. Thus, the DENR is mandated to work with Local Government Units (LGUs), People's Organizations (Pos), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), Religious Groups, Business and Industry sectors and other concerned organizations to ensure that communities are empowered to initiate and achieve the objectives of this Order (Section No. 6)

2. FMB Technical Bulletin No. 20 and Section 18 of DAO 2004-29, also indicates that the CRMF is a strategic plan of the community on how to manage and benefit from the forest resources on a sustainable basis. It describes the community's long term vision, aspirations, commitments, and strategies for the protection, rehabilitation, development, and utilization of forest resources. The CRMF shall provide specific activities for the first five (5) years, which shall serve as the Five Year Work Plan of the Peoples Organization.

PROGRESS REPORT

The So.Yapang Outpost Community Based Forest Management Association, Inc. is registered at the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) on March 6, 2003 under **SEC Registration No. 200305601**. A Community Based Forest Management (CBFMA) issued by the Regional Office in December 18, 2002 and to expire on December 18, 2027 under CBFMA Registration No. **RIV-OCCMIN-CBFM-2002-13** with 71 registered members.

In CY 2020, the CENRO Sablayan GIS Personnel conducted re-survey the 237.3 hectares awarded to So. Yapang Outpost Community Based Forest Management Association Inc. The re-survey team submitted GIS maps in accordance with the FMB Technical Bulletin No. 21-A also known as the guidelines in the Assessment, Re-survey and Mapping of areas covered by CBFMA and other Tenure Agreement.

The livelihood adopted by the community was per household basis like planting of cash crops, banana, corn, rice, cacao, camote, coffee, gabi and cassava. For 2021, this community is also a recipient of livelihood program under CARP fund, providing them cooking paraphernalia to be used in the production of Banana chips and other available root crops projected to be displayed/sold in the target market place. The Project Cost is Php 180,000.00.

On May 31, 2023 the monitoring was conducted. According to PO Chairman Annie Reyes, they are still looking for the supplier of slicer to be used in the production of banana chips.

The PO Chairman also informed us that they just paid the penalty to BIR amounting to P18, 000.00. BIR is one of the requirements to open their Land Bank account. The PO's Land bank account is still on process and waiting for the approval of the Land Bank main Office

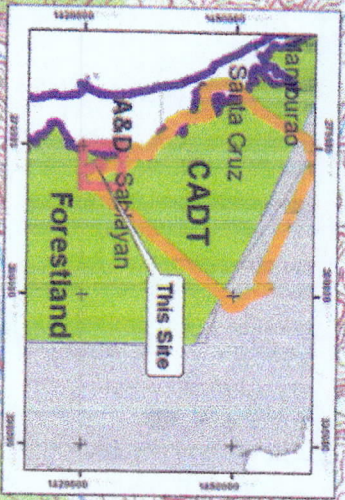
