In connection with the sightings of a vessel on the waters of Sta. Cruz, Occidental Mindoro, the undersigned went to the area to confirm the veracity of the reports.

According to Brgy. Chairperson Geronimo S. Aguilar of Brgy. Poblacion 1, they received a copy of the letter addressed to the Municipal Mayor's Office. In the letter, the Provincial Government Office is authorizing the conduct of Marine and Coastal Surveys by the KKC Construction and Development Corp. and Front Nine Construct on May 31, 2023. This is part of addressing the problems in flooding of the municipality. Moreover, he presented a document signed by CENRO Anastacio A. Santos certifying that the proposed area for dredging has no negative impact on the turtle nesting sites.

No vessel came on the said date, however, on the early morning of June 6th, a vessel was sighted on their waters along Brgy. Poblacion I. According to Mr. Aguilar, the Provincial Government then confirmed to them that it was the same vessel that was supposed to conduct a survey on May 31st, but was not able to continue due to the typhoon at that time.

The vessel only stayed for around three hours then left. The Philippine Coast Guard was present while the vessel was there.

The undersigned went to the Philippine Coast Guard in Mamburao to gather additional information. CG PO3 Fedirick James N. Holgado confirmed the assistance of the Philippine Coast Guard when the vessel came to Sta. Cruz. According to him CG SCPO Ferdinand G. Navarette, the Substation Commander, boarded the vessel himself. Since Mr. Navarette is currently unavailable due to a work-related-travel, Mr. Holgado advised for another meeting once their commander comes back.




