

Anent above-subject, respectfully submitted is the request to change commodity from Fruit Trees to Indigenous Trees within the former areas of NGP partners, Jennifer Gumasing and Anthony Suarez wherein this Office was granted to continue its maintenance and protection activities.

Below are the grounds regarding the request, to wit:

- 1. Based on the observation/ evaluation of the 2021 eNGP plantation, the species of Fruit Trees have high mortality rate within the vicinities of CENRO San Jose due to climate condition especially on summer season and rodent infestation.
- 2. Difficulty in seedling production since Fruit Trees are not adaptable in most of the area of SAMARICA.
